A. Student Programs and Services

4045 Housing Service

The Governing Board of Monterey Peninsula College recognizes the importance of housing needs for students. It therefore offers a Housing Service to act as a liaison between students and members of the local community who have rentals that are identified as available to students. The Housing Service does not discriminate against any students and will not accept a listing that obviously or openly violates the affirmative action guidelines of the College.

The existence of this service does not guarantee students the availability of housing on the peninsula. Its function is to list available housing, requirements for occupancy or rental, and make that information available to students, in addition to information on how to contact the person(s) who have requested the listing.

The selection of a particular student or decision to rent to a Monterey Peninsula College student is the responsibility of the person who has requested the listing. Monterey Peninsula College does not accept the responsibility for the behavior of any student referred through the Housing Service, for any debts created by a student related to a rental acquired through a Housing Service referral, or for the threatening of a student by a landlord or landlady.
