A. Student Programs and Services

4050 Education Community Volunteer Program

The Governing Board of Monterey Peninsula College recognizes the importance of experiential learning as a part of the education of students. To provide the opportunity to gain experience through volunteering, the Education Community Volunteer Program has been created.

This program is aimed at providing students with College credit for volunteer work they perform with local non-profit, public agencies and private agencies related to the academic major of the student. Students are not eligible for pay while earning unit credit for volunteer work in this program.
