E. Student Government and Activities

4420 Advisors and Sponsors for Student Clubs and Organizations

Each club or organization approved by the Associated Students of Monterey Peninsula College (ASMP) as an officially recognized student organization of the student body of Monterey Peninsula College must have an employee of the District as an advisor. Advisors will supervise, as necessary, meetings and official activities, including mandatory supervision of financial transactions, of the club or organization. Advisors will do what is prudent to ensure proper conduct in actions of the group for which they are responsible, but otherwise their duties are primarily advisory.

All authorized student functions must have proper chaperonage. Each advisor is expected to assume his or her share of this responsibility as determined by the Dean of Student Services. Student club and organization advisors are required to chaperone and/or provide for proper chaperonage for all the activities of his or her club or organization as required by this policy.

Student organizations and clubs, which wish to engage in off-campus activities, which require a chaperone, shall first receive approval from the Dean of Student Services. The College reserves the right to approve or deny College staff as chaperones, based on their individual interests, personal convictions or desires, and familiarity or lack thereof with College policy.
