

MILITARY RESIDENCE FORM

-STATEMENT-

If you are the dependent of an active duty member of the U.S. Armed Forces assigned to California and wish to request exemption from non-resident tuition, you must complete the below statement and obtain the signature of the active duty member's commending officer or personnel officer.

TO: SPOUSES AND CHILDREN OF ALL U.S. ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY ASSIGNED TO CALIFORNIA.

Because of your military dependent status, upon completion of the below form, you are exempt from non-resident tuition as long as the U.S. active duty member is assigned to California.

The residency determination date is the date immediately preceding the opening of a semester/session.

For educational purposes, California resident depends not only on continuous physical presence in the state for one year immediately preceding the opening of a semester/session, but also on acting toward establishing residency and intent to make California the home for other than a temporary purpose. This is done by filing state income tax forms as a resident, by voting as a resident, and by having a California driver's license. Documents must be dated at least one year before the semester/session begins. Copies of these items will be required at the time the request is submitted. The one-year resident period which a student must meet to be classified as a resident does not begin until the student is both present in California and has manifested interest to become a California resident (i.e.: registering to vote, obtaining a California driver's license, filing California state income tax as a resident and not possessing documents contradicting California residence). The burden is on the student to demonstrate clearly both physical presence in California and intent to establish California residence.

The law governing residence determination for tuition purposes may be found in the California Education Code and in Title 5 of the California Administrative Code. If you have any questions, please contact the MPC Admissions and Records Office at 646-4007.
