Course descriptions: Through lectures and slides these courses trace the development of the art of Western Civilization from the ancient world, through the Middle Ages and the Renaissance, to 1520 A.D. (ART 2) and from the Protestant Reformation (1520) up to the late 20th century (ART 3).

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Master's in fine arts, art, or art history **OR**
- Bachelor's in any of the above **AND** Master's in humanities **OR**
- CA Community College Teaching Credential in Art **OR**
- The equivalent. To select outstanding faculty members from the largest possible pool of qualified applicants, Monterey Peninsula College recognizes that candidates may have attained expertise in the subject through a variety of means. Certain combinations of education, experience, and other accomplishments may be judged by the District as equivalent to a master's degree for this position. Candidates who feel they possess such equivalent qualifications are encouraged to obtain and complete an **EQUIVALENCY APPLICATION** from the Human Resources Department and provide appropriate documentation of their qualifications; **AND**
- Sensitivity to and understanding of the diverse academic, socioeconomic, gender, cultural, disability, and ethnic backgrounds of community college students

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

- Teaching assignments are part-time and temporary in nature. Assignments are subject to Governing Board approval, adequate enrollment size, and assignment to a contract instructor.
- Offer and assignment of employment is subject to verification of all information provided on the employment application, credential, transcripts, fingerprint check, and tuberculosis examination as required.
- Salary Rate: \$47.17 - \$57.60 per hour, based on education
