**Course Title:**           **AUTO 100 Introduction to Auto Technology**

**Days and Times:**       6 weekly hours to be determined

**Start Date:**             February 1<sup>st</sup> through June 3<sup>rd</sup>

**Course Description:**   This course provides an introduction to the automotive technology program and profession. It is a survey course covering the basic operation and maintenance of the modern automobile. Students gain laboratory experience performing service and minor repairs.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Bachelor degree plus 2 years of related occupational experience **OR**
- Associate degree and 6 years of related occupational experience **OR**
- The equivalent. When requesting equivalency, it is the applicant's responsibility to request an equivalency request form and return it with the application **AND**
- Commitment to community college goals/objectives of providing quality programs and services for culturally, socio-economically, ethnically, and academically diverse students and students with disabilities; personal qualities to work effectively and sensitively in a multicultural environment; awareness of and commitment to the needs of non-traditional and/or re-entry students

### **CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:**

- Teaching assignments are part-time and temporary in nature. Assignments are subject to Governing Board approval, adequate enrollment size and assignment to a contract instructor.
- Offer and assignment of employment is subject to verification of all information provided on the employment application, credential, transcripts, fingerprint check, and tuberculosis examination as required.
- Starting Salary Rate: \$43.53 - \$54.49 per hour, based on education and occupational experience.
