# Student Financial Services Checklist

All documents that apply to you and your financial aid file need to be received by the Student Financial Aid Office by June 19, 2009 to be considered for disbursement on the 2nd day of the Fall semester.

Documents can be downloaded from the MPC website at [www.mpc.edu](http://www.mpc.edu).

This is your receipt. Please bring this form with you each time you submit documentation.

- Complete the FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) either by going online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) or by mailing off a completed paper application. Call the office at 646-4030 to inquire about our free workshops to help you complete the FAFSA online. Our Title IV Federal Code is #001242. You will receive a **Student Aid Report (SAR)** either by mail, or email from the Department of Education.

- For **Cal Grant** consideration, applicants must meet the Cal Grant Deadlines. Complete the **Cal Grant GPA Verification Form** in January or February and submit it to the Admissions and Records Office for certification of our GPA. If you are in high school, or have no GPA you will need to speak with a counselor.

- Student Information Form:** You must complete the Student Information Form to be considered for financial aid.

- To be considered for the maximum amount of aid you must be **enrolled for Fall semester** by August 12, 2009.

- Excessive Units Form:** If you have completed more than 60 units total (MPC and other Colleges units) you must complete the Excessive Units Form. This form must be completed with an academic counselor.

- Prior College Transcripts:** If you have attended another college or university you must request a transcript be sent to the Admissions and Records Office. It is your responsibility to make sure the transcripts are reviewed and posted into the computer system by Admissions and Records.

- Ability to Benefit:** (ATB) If you have not graduated from high school or have no GED, you must pass an Ability to Benefit Test. Please call 646-4246 to find out when you can arrange to take the ATB test.

- Verification:** If your SAR (Student Aid Report) states that you are selected for a process called **Verification**, you must submit:

- An Independent or Dependent Verification Worksheet.
- Independent students must submit a signed copy of their 2008 Federal Income Tax Return and all W-2's. If married, a signed copy of your spouse's 2008 Return with W-2's, if filed separately.
- Dependent students must submit a signed copy of their 2008 Federal Income Tax Return and all W-2's, plus a signed copy of their parent's 2008 Income Tax Return and all W-2's.
- Proof of any untaxed income listed on the SAR.
