Then, we do a survey 6 months after graduation of employer satisfaction with the graduates who are hired at the three major hospitals in our area: CHOMP, Natividad Medical Center, and Salinas Valley Memorial Hospital.

This is from our Program Evaluation Meeting minutes. We don't have anything that we maintain electronically, but you can post these statistics if you want.

A survey of employment plans revealed that the 41 new graduates have accepted their first position as follows:
