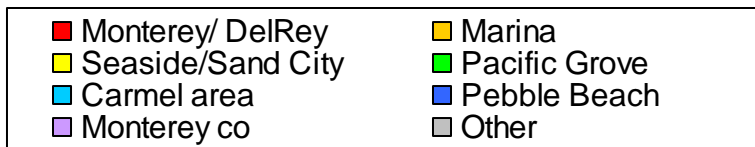
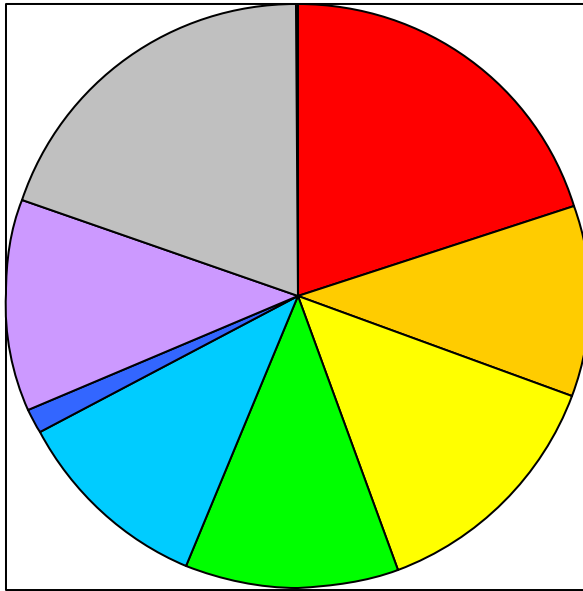


Headcount Trends - Students

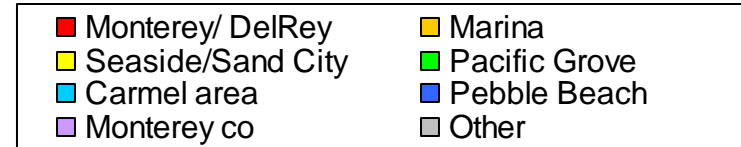
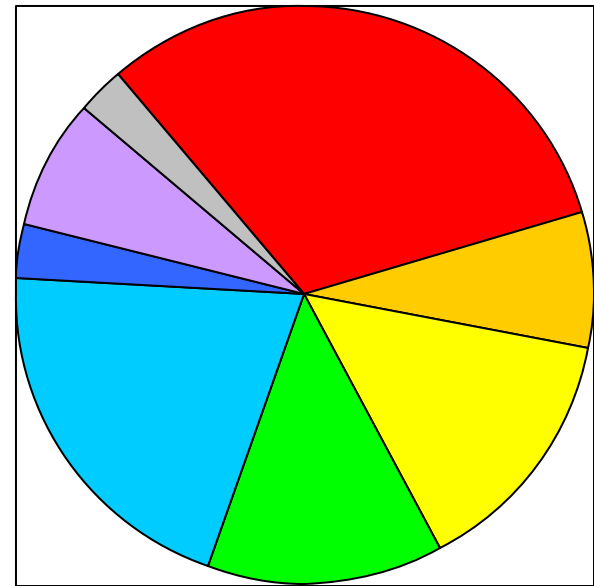


City of Residence

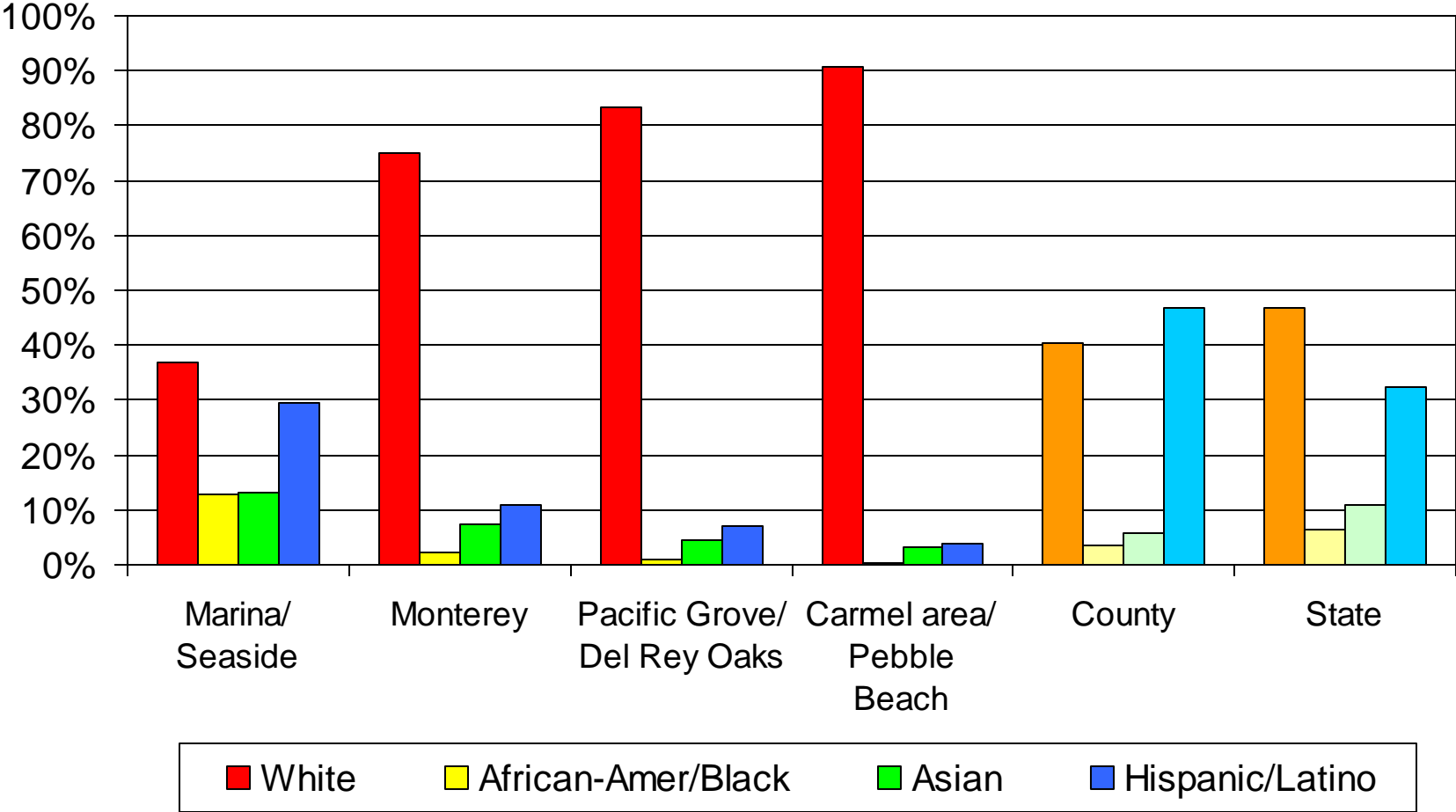

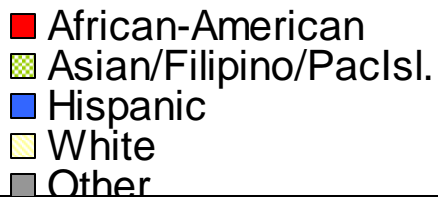

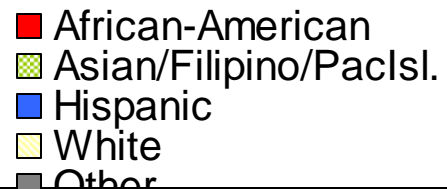

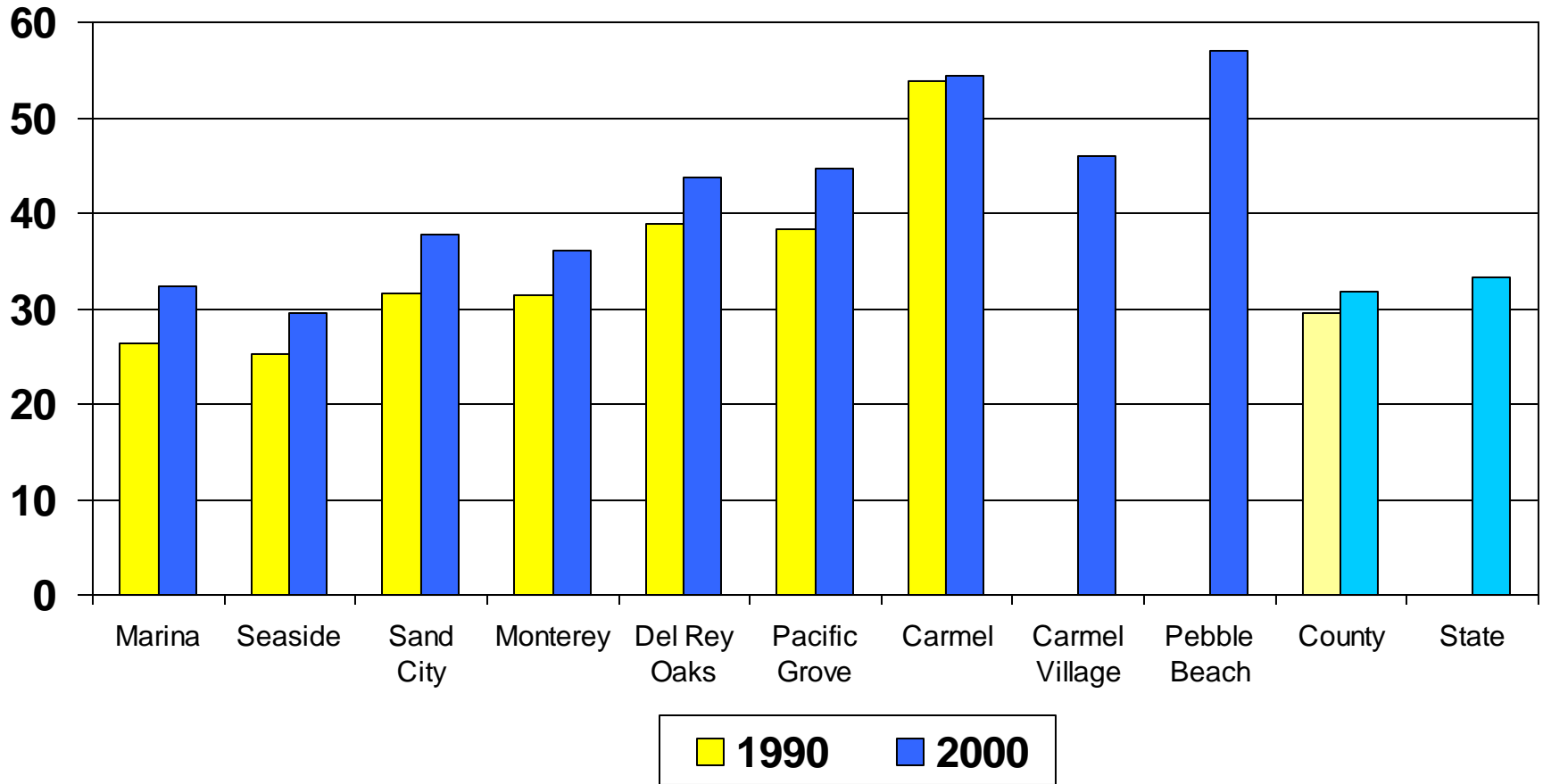

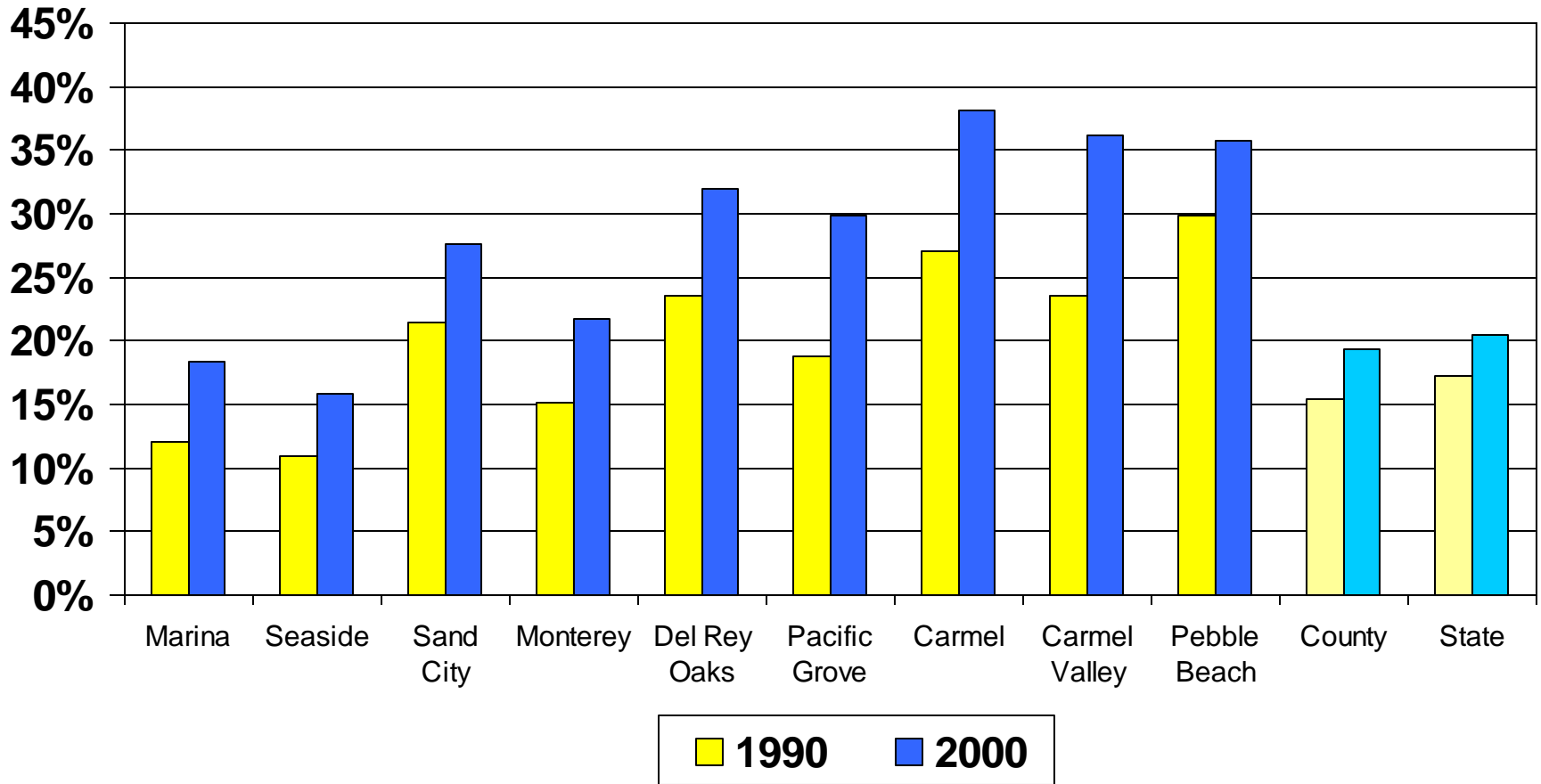


Median Age - Community



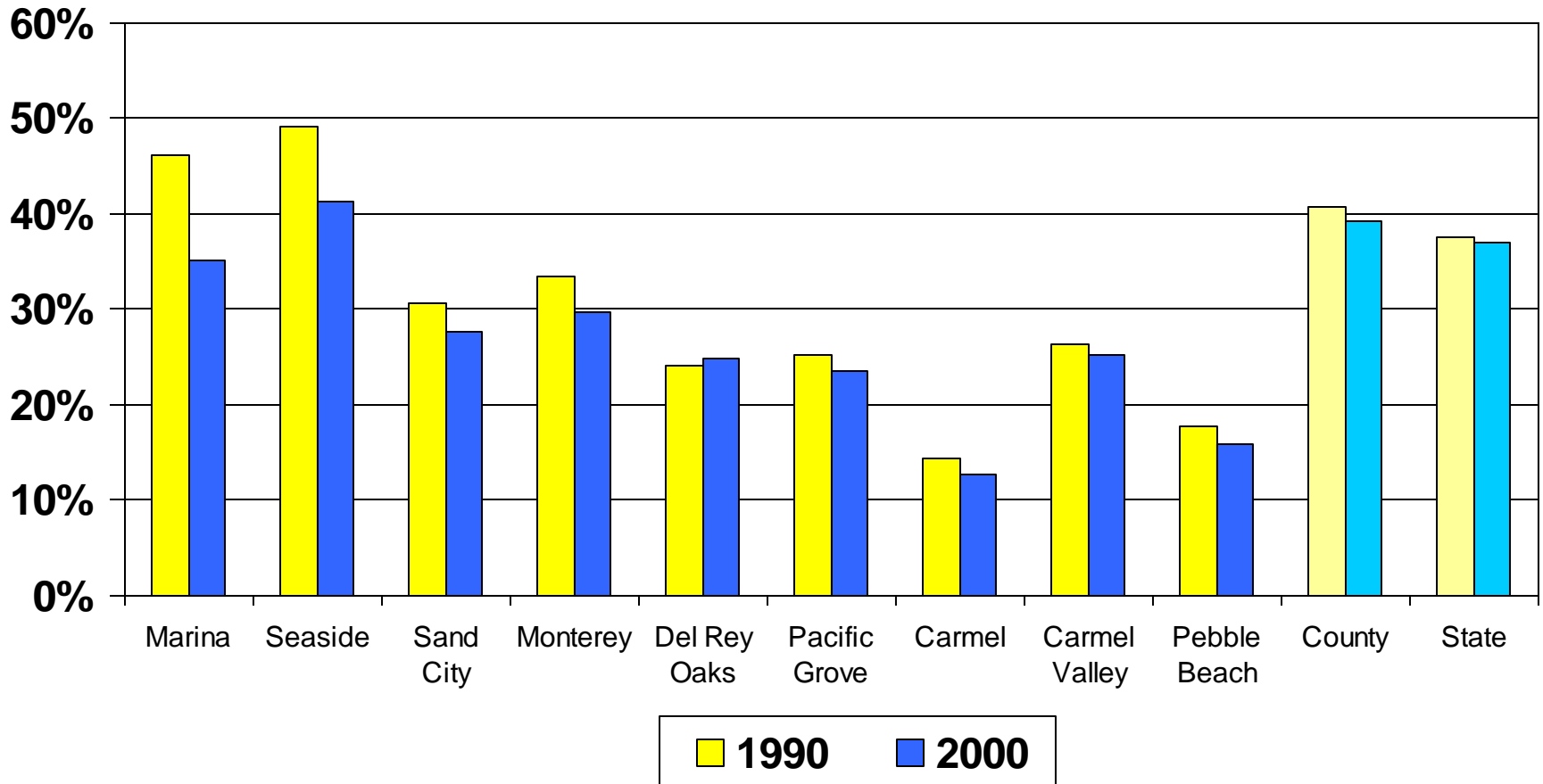
Age - Community

Percentage of population age 45 to 64 years

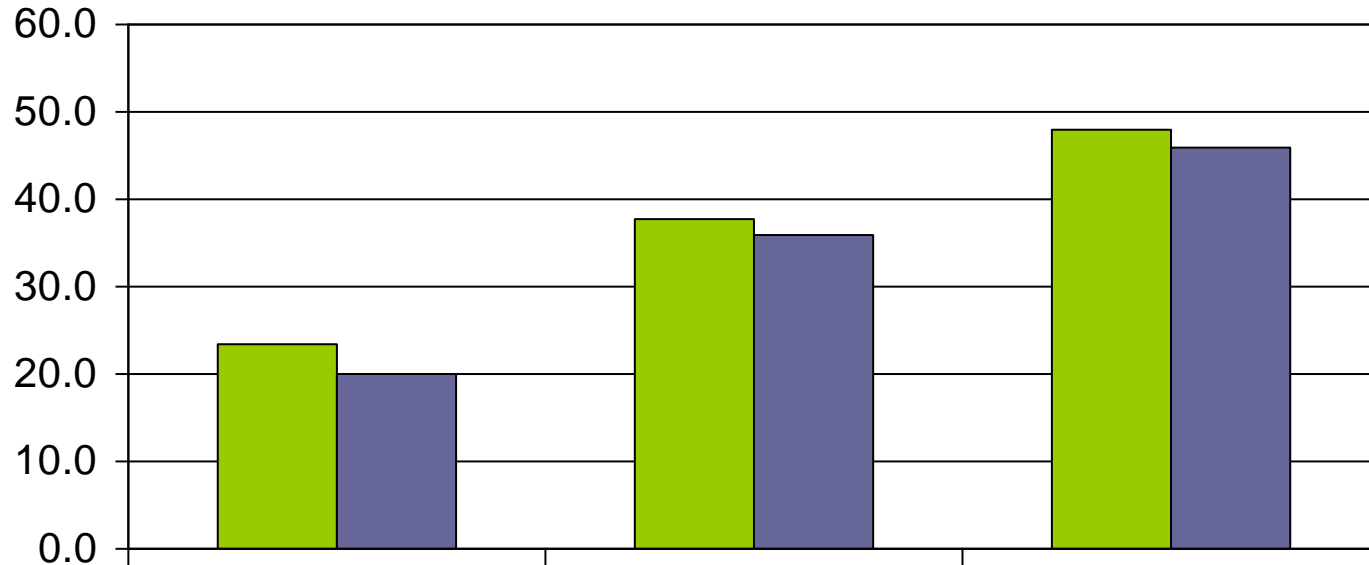


Age – Community

Percentage of population under 25 years

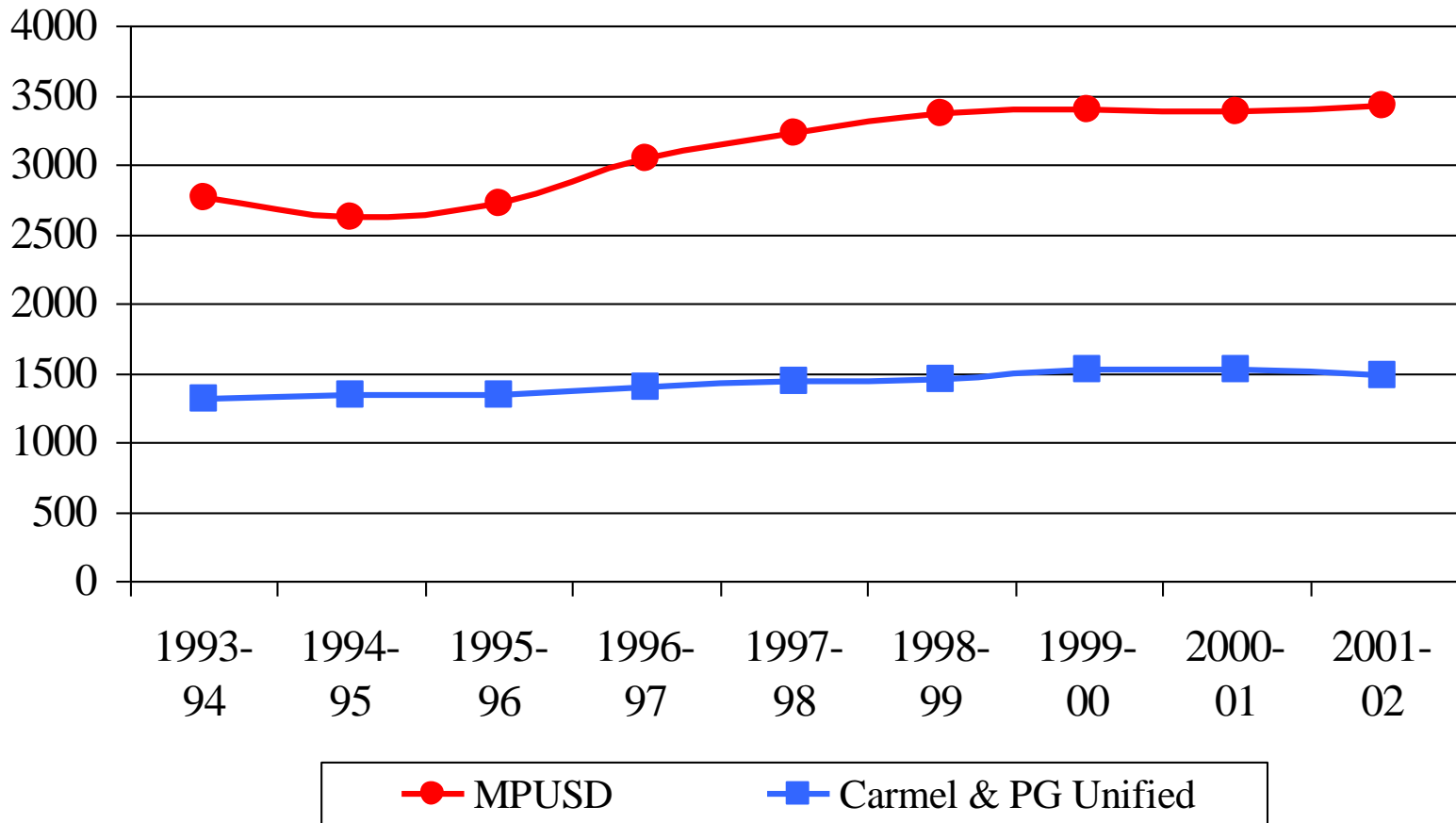

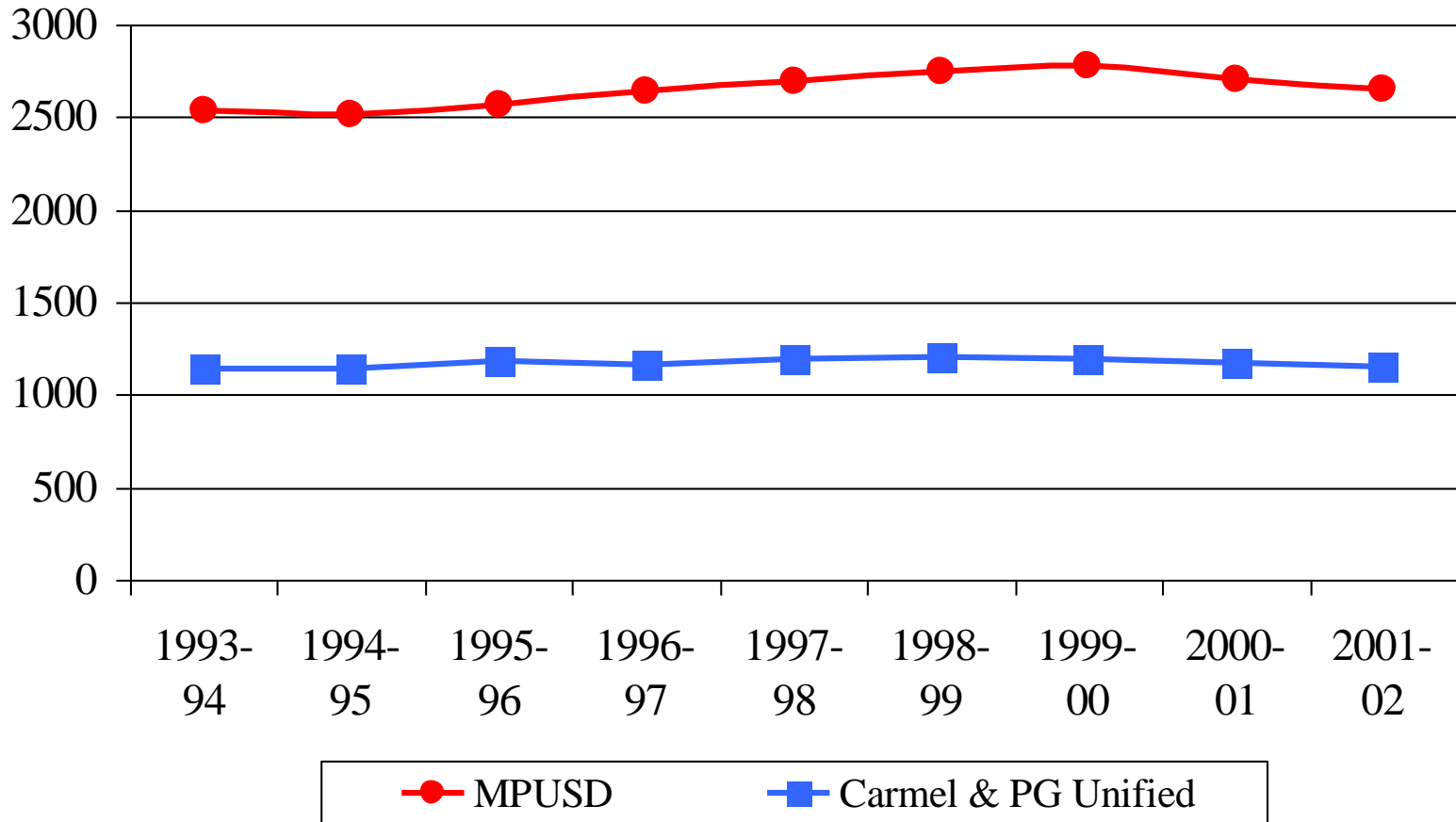

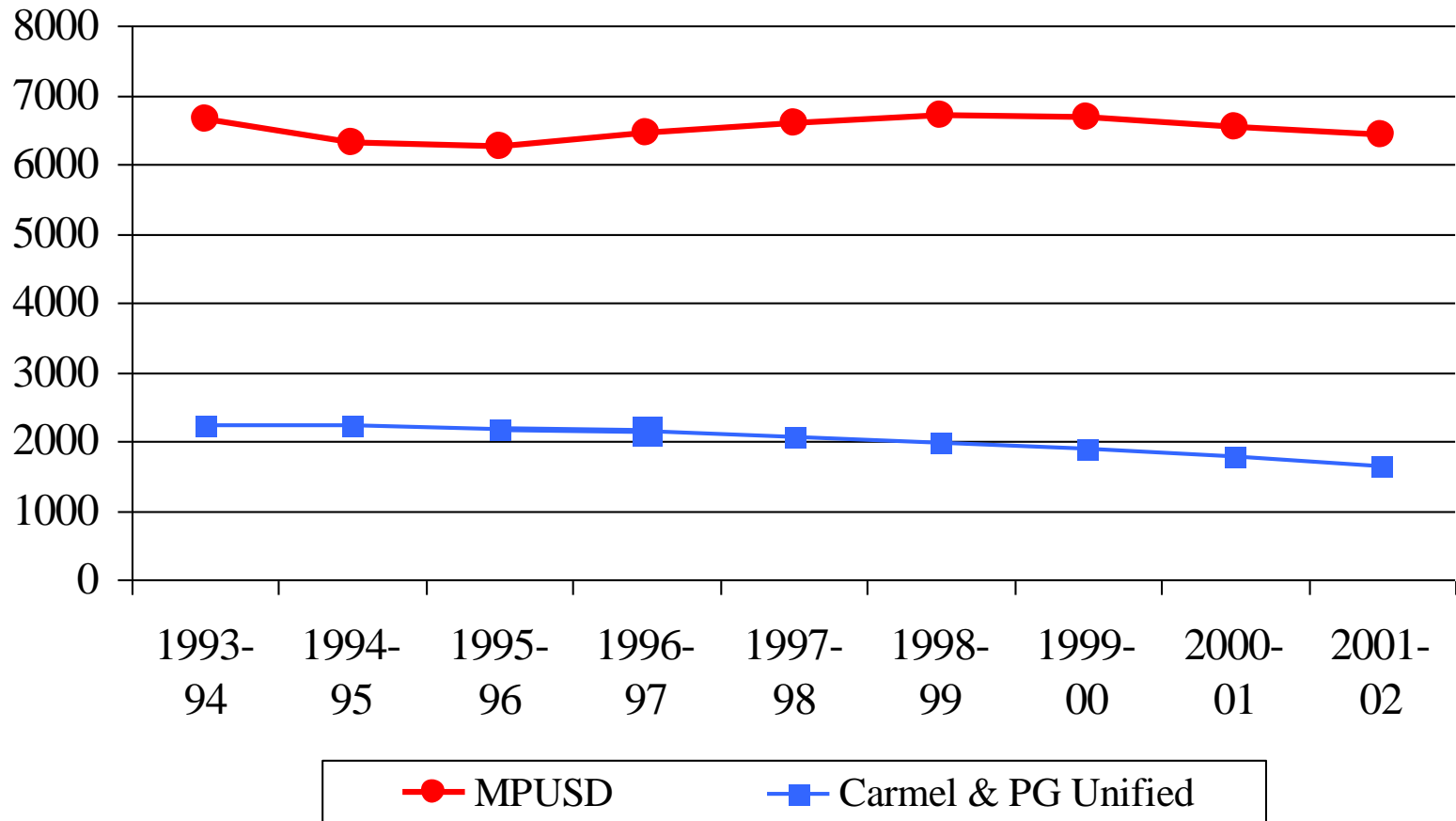
Public High School Enrollment



Public Middle School Enrollment

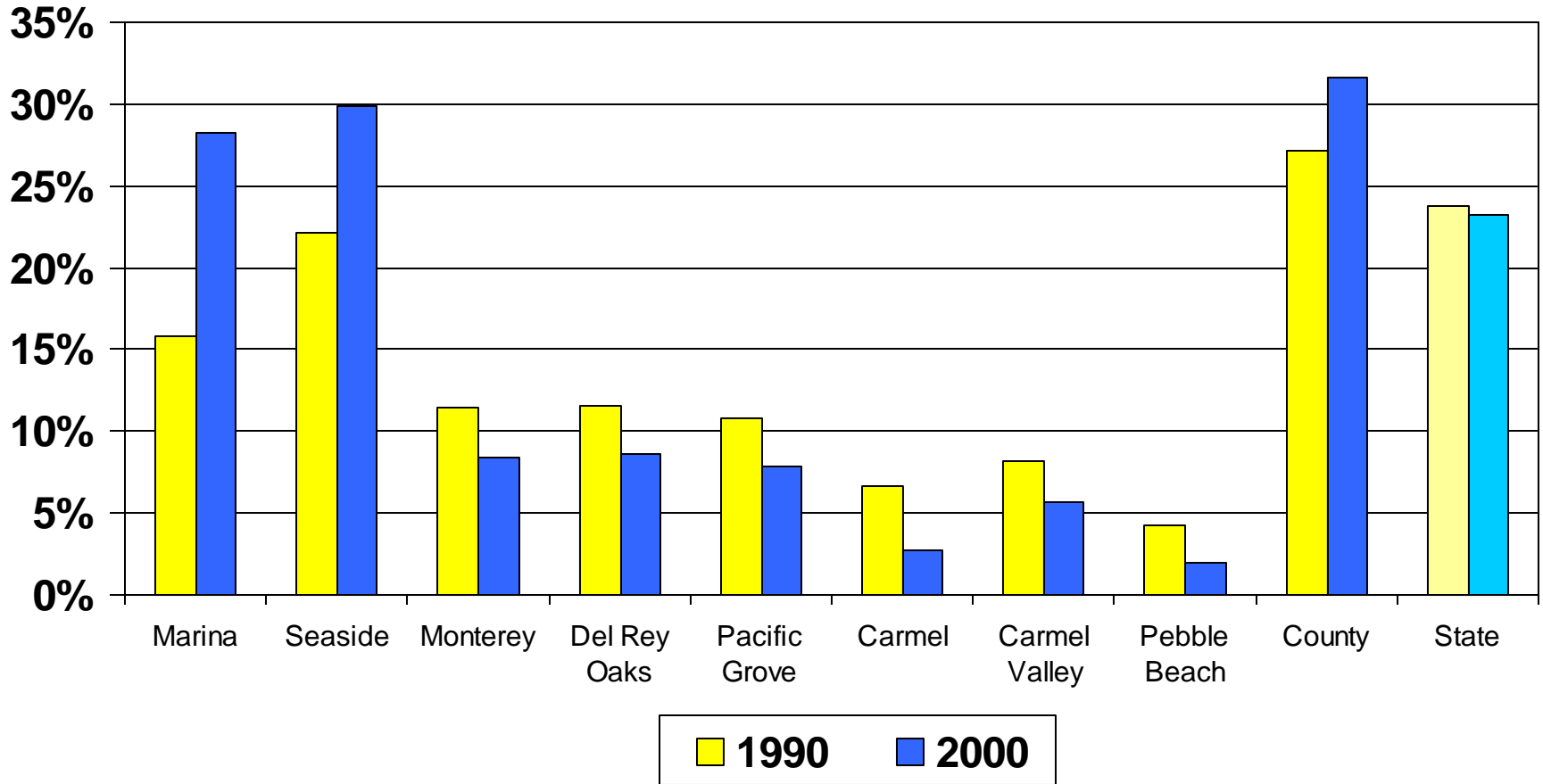


Public Elementary School Enrollment



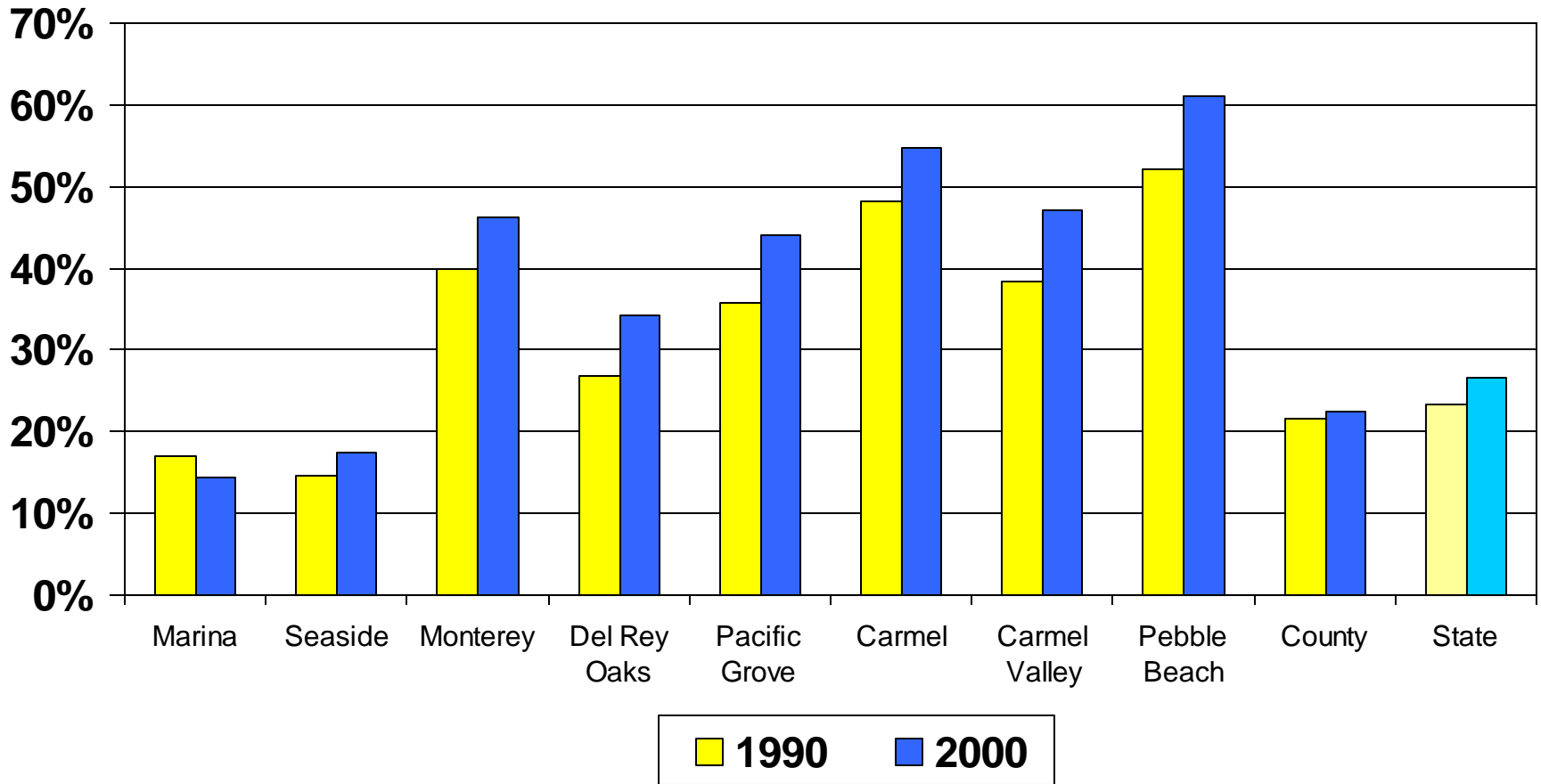
Educational Attainment – Community

Percentage of population w/o HS diploma



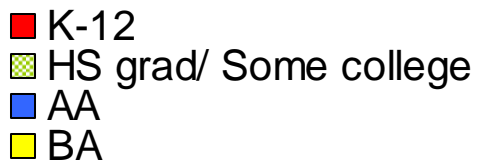
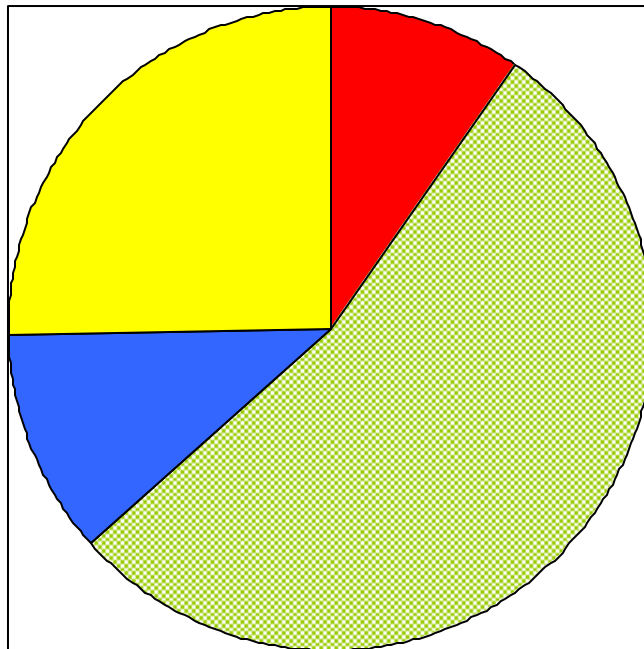
Educational Attainment - Community

Percentage of population w/ bachelor's or higher

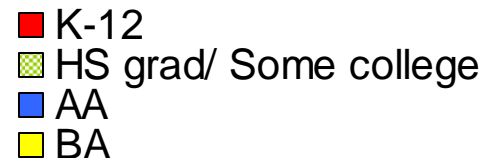
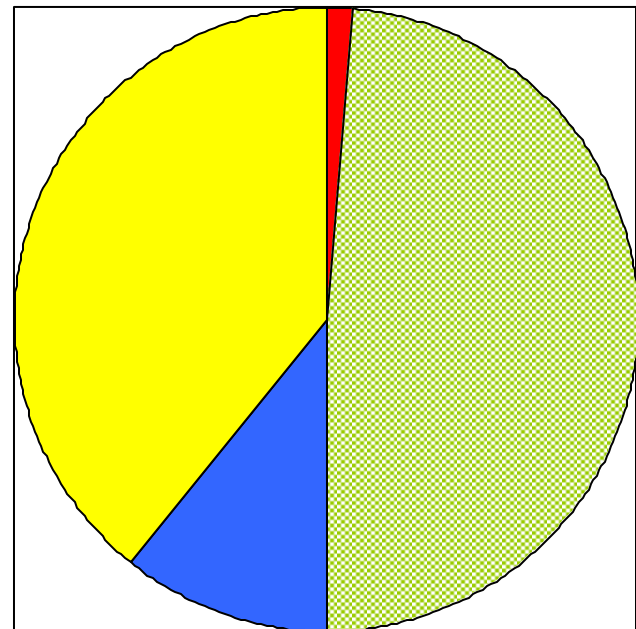

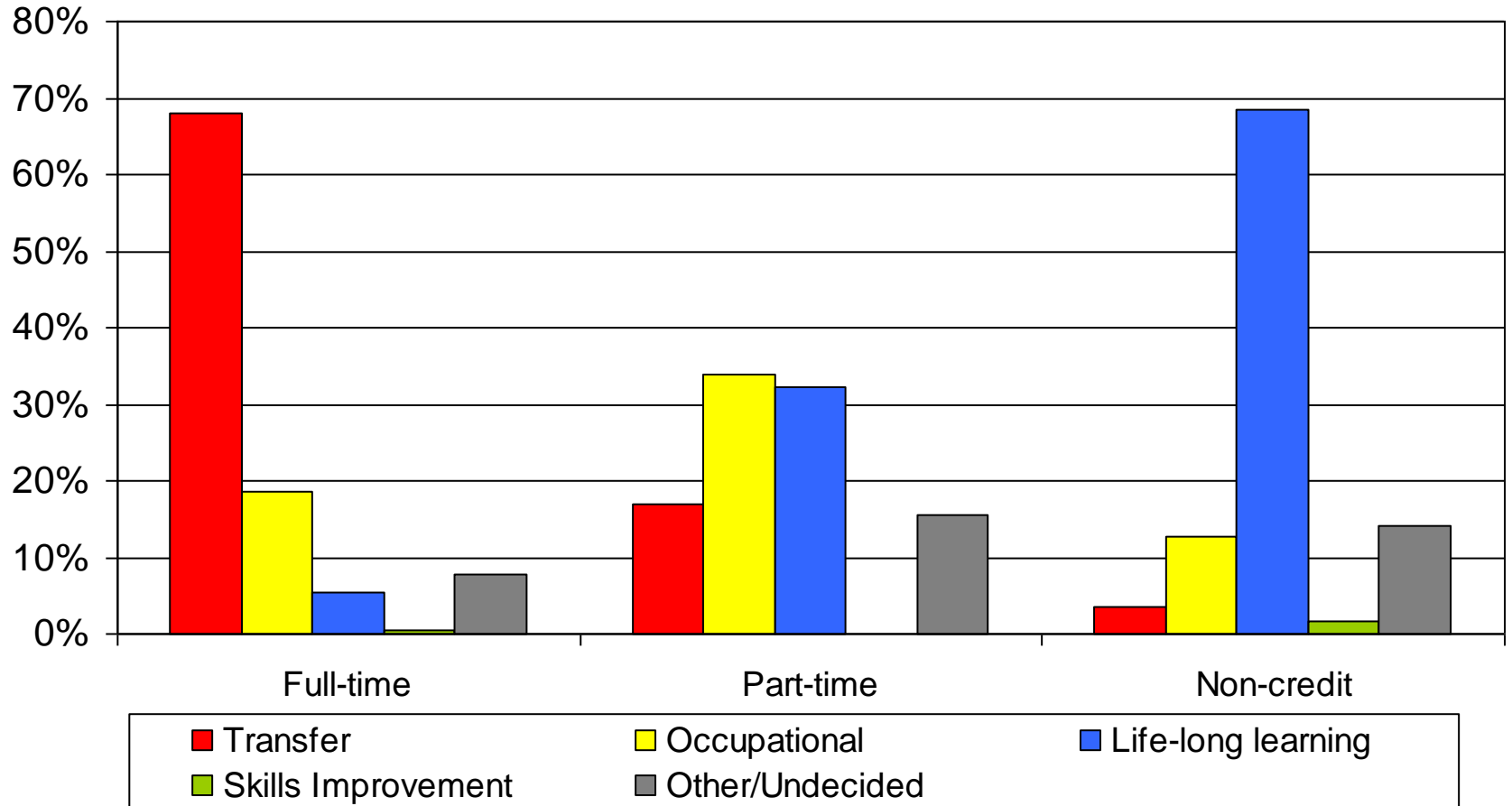

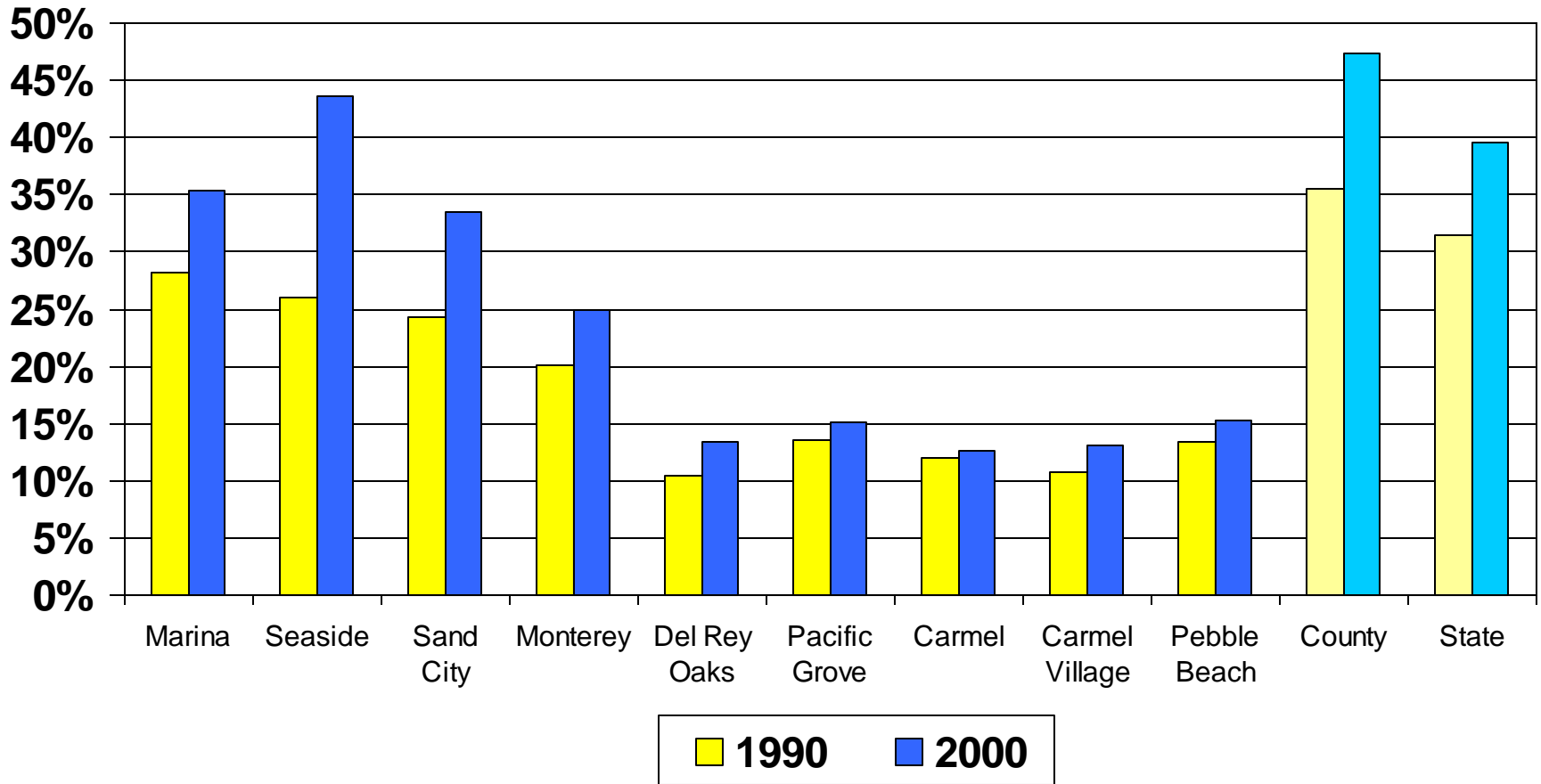

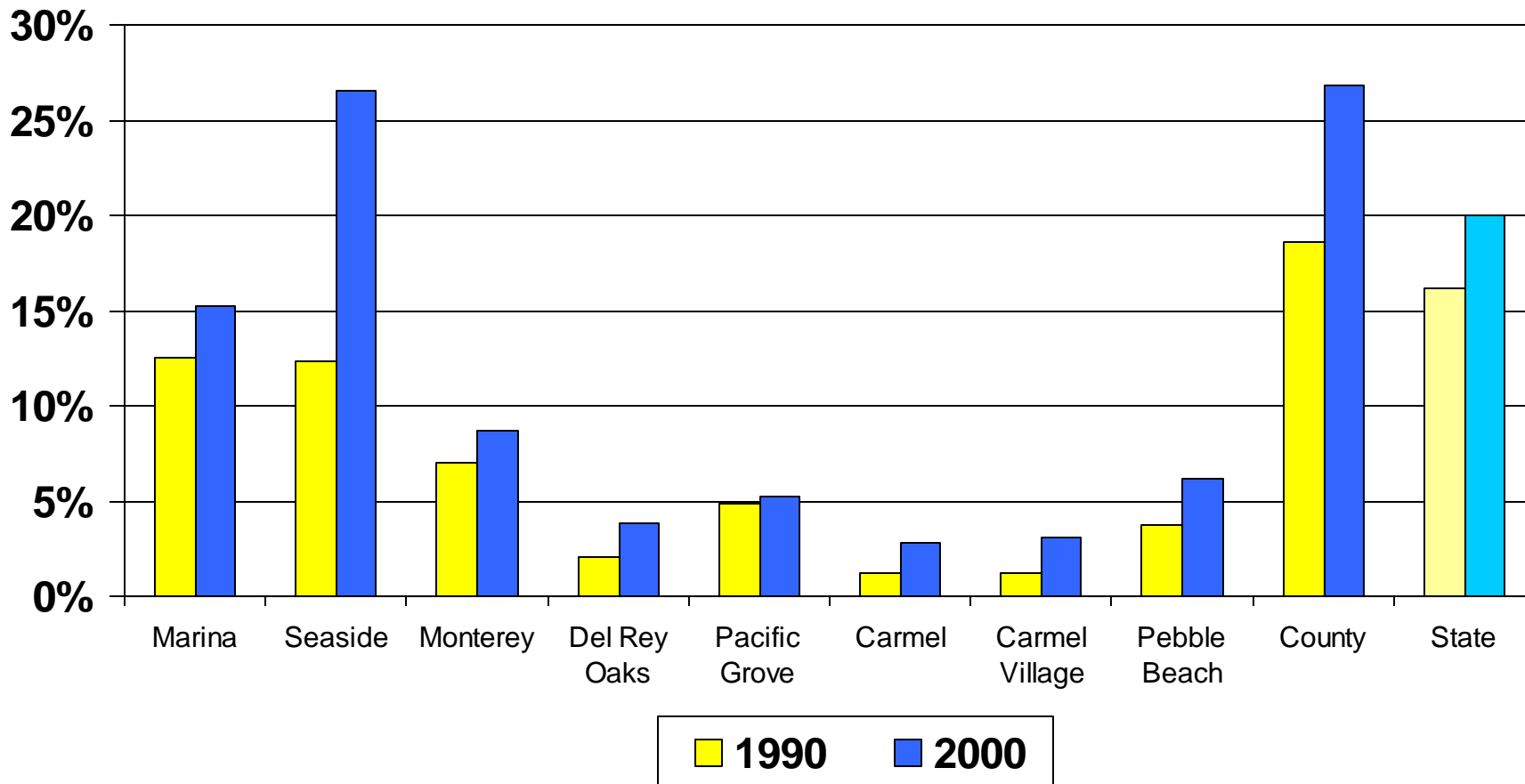
Language - Community

Percentage who speak language other than English

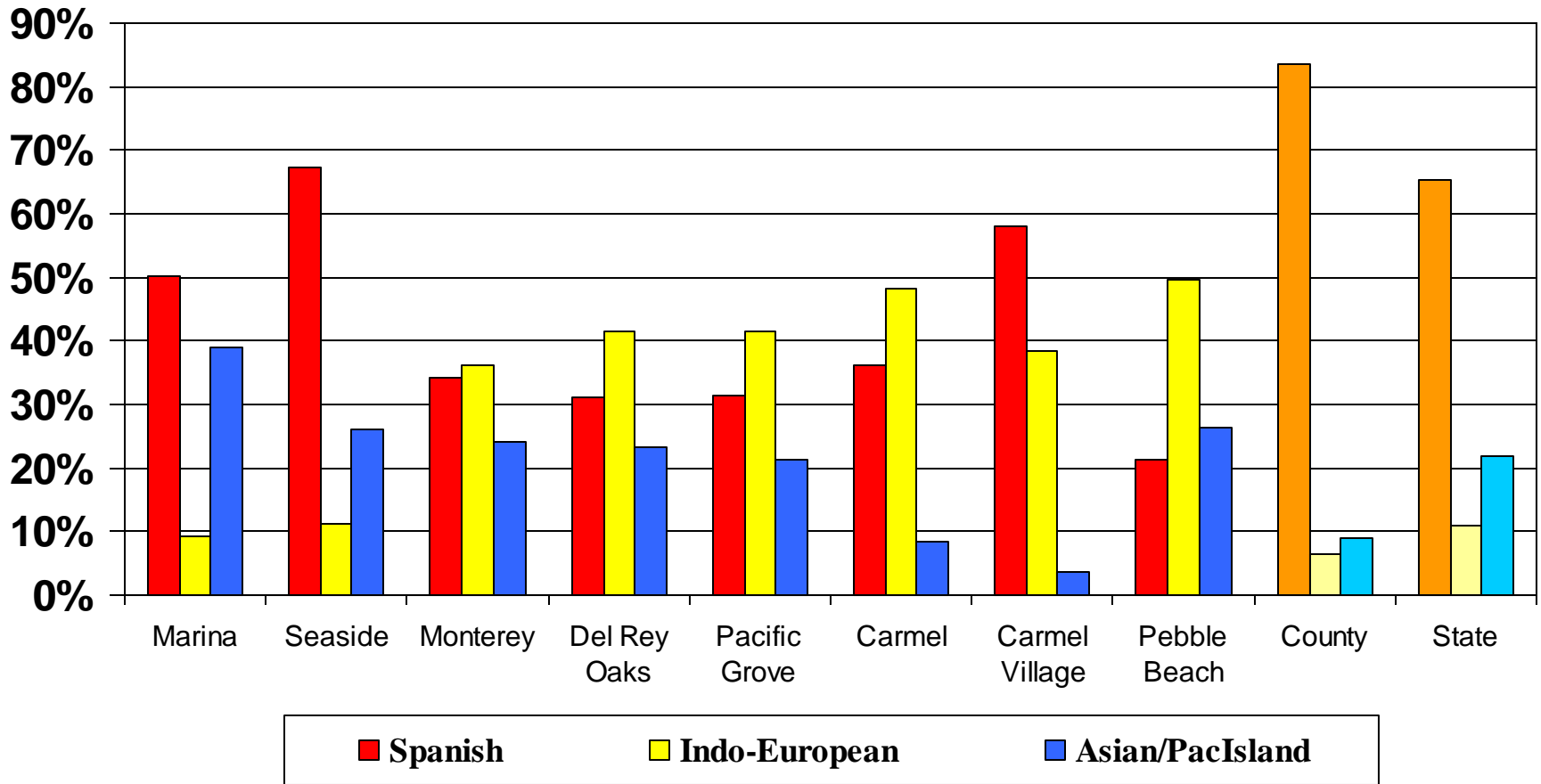

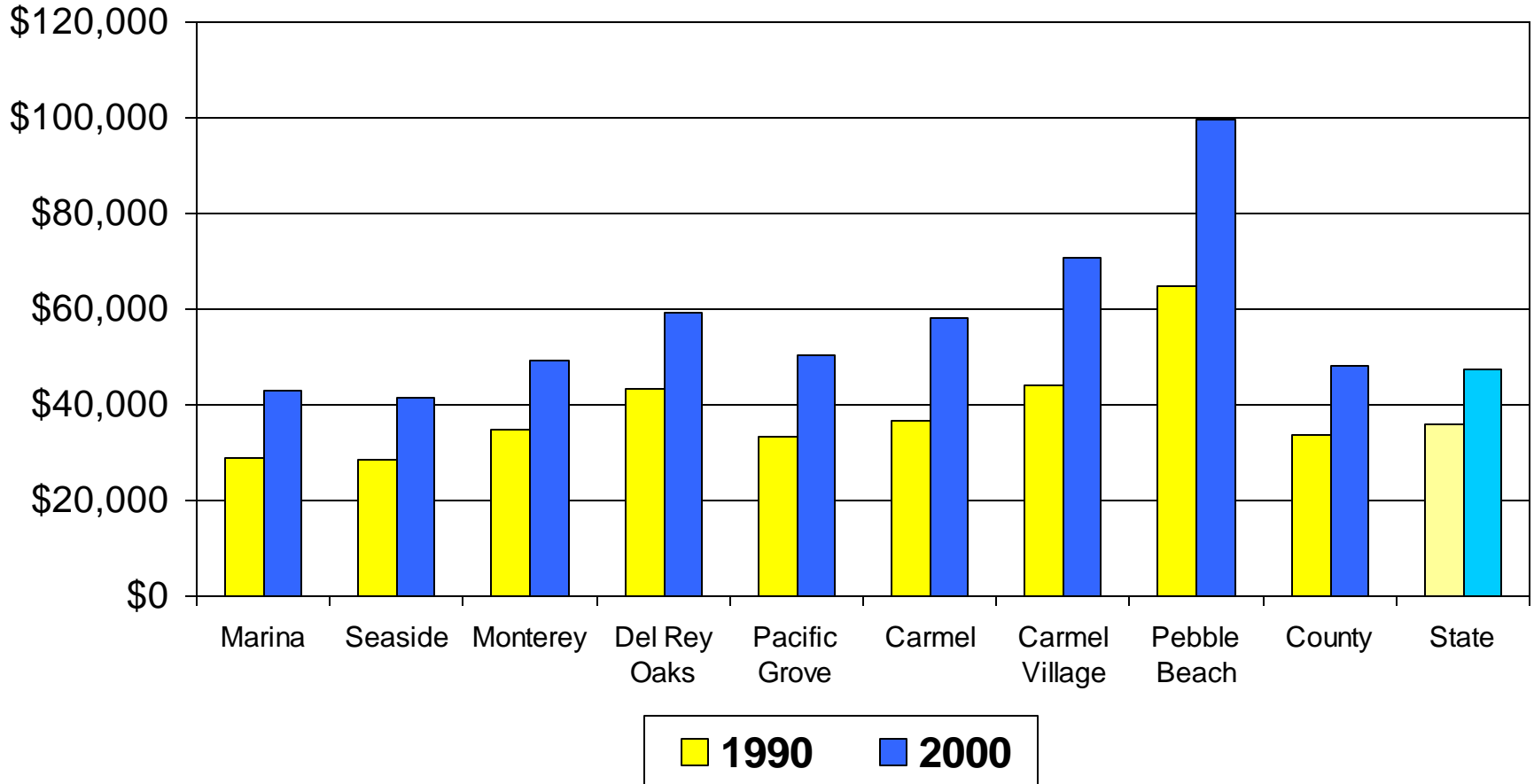
Percentage who speak English less than “very well”



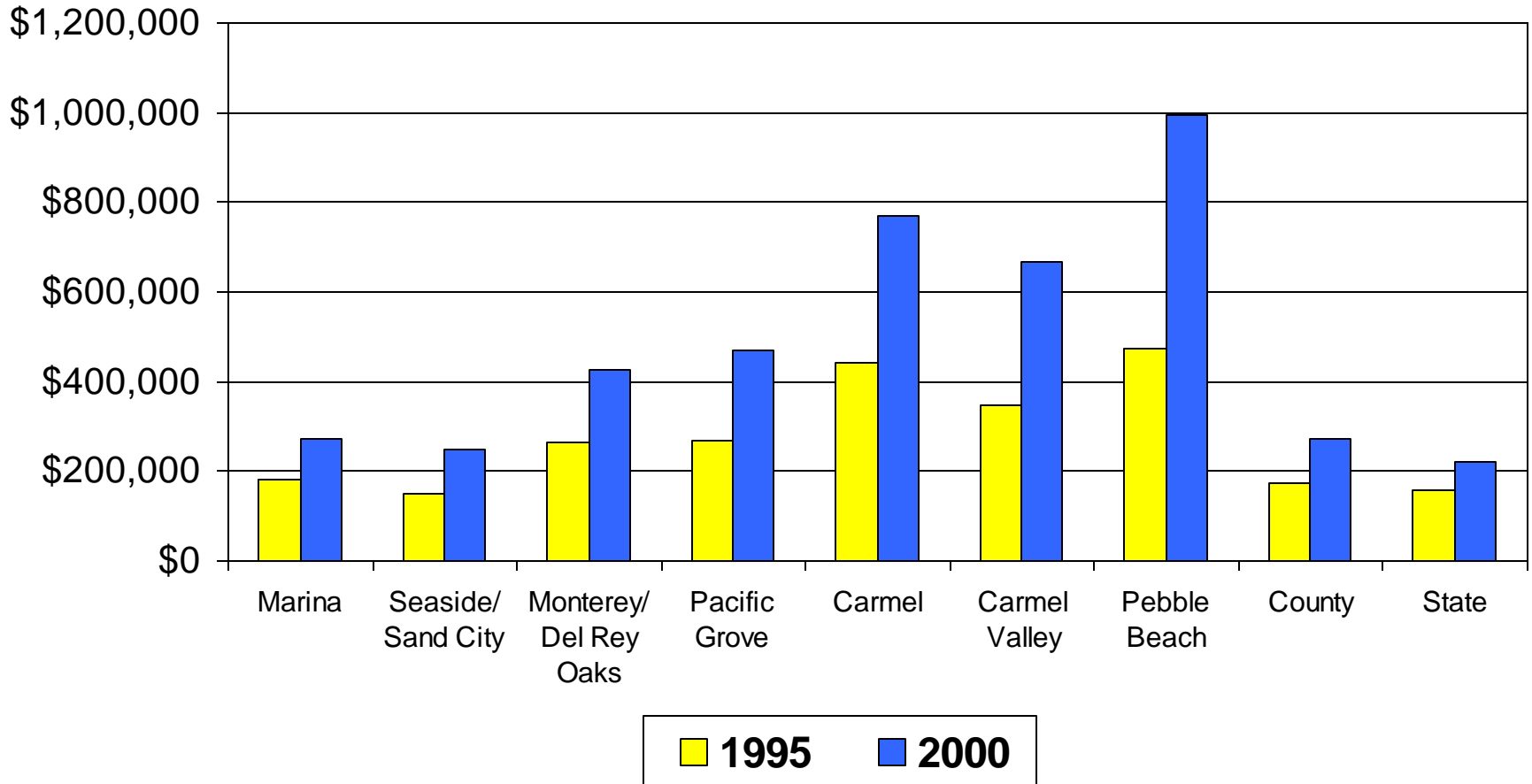
Language Spoken - Community



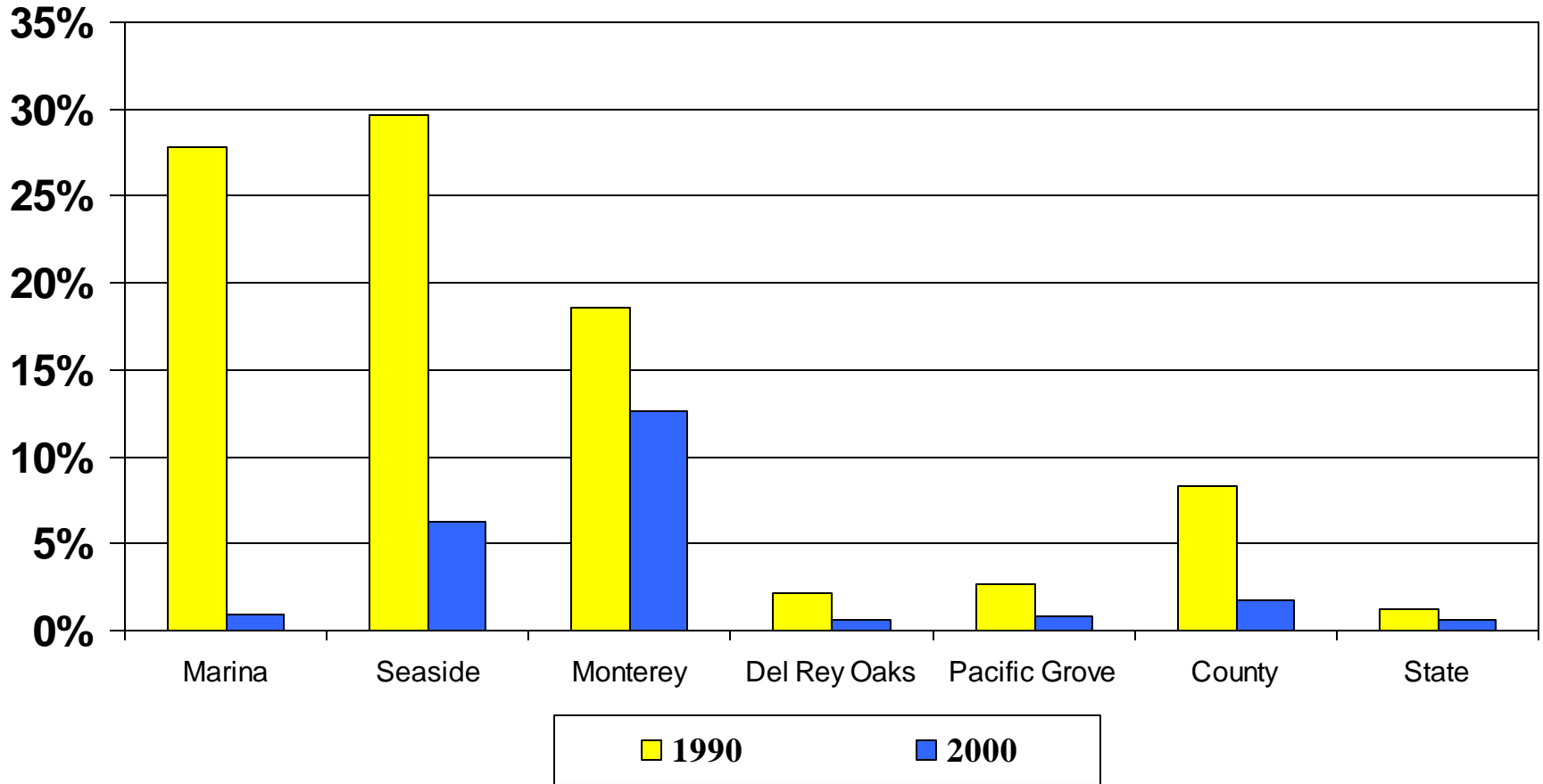

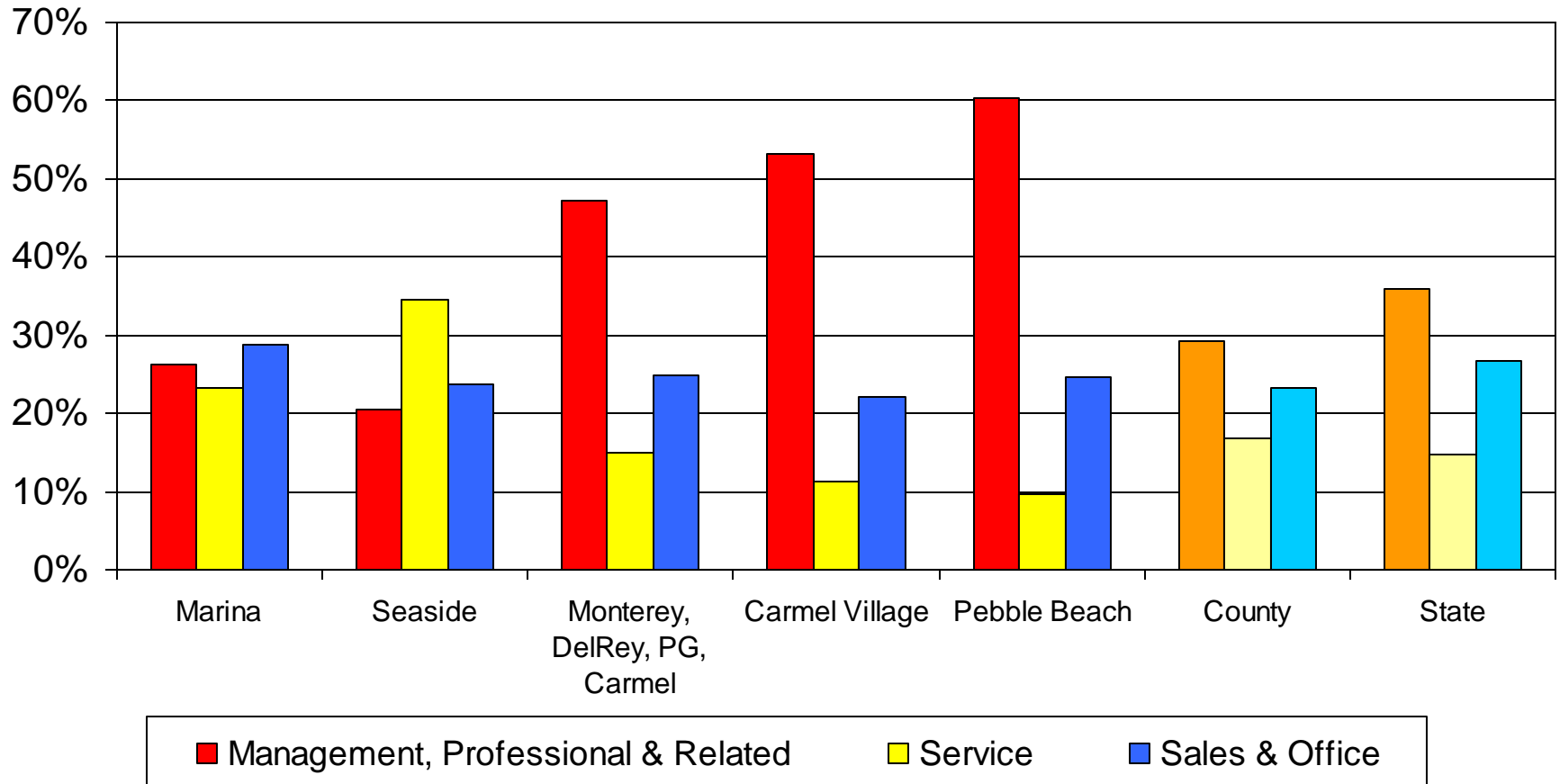

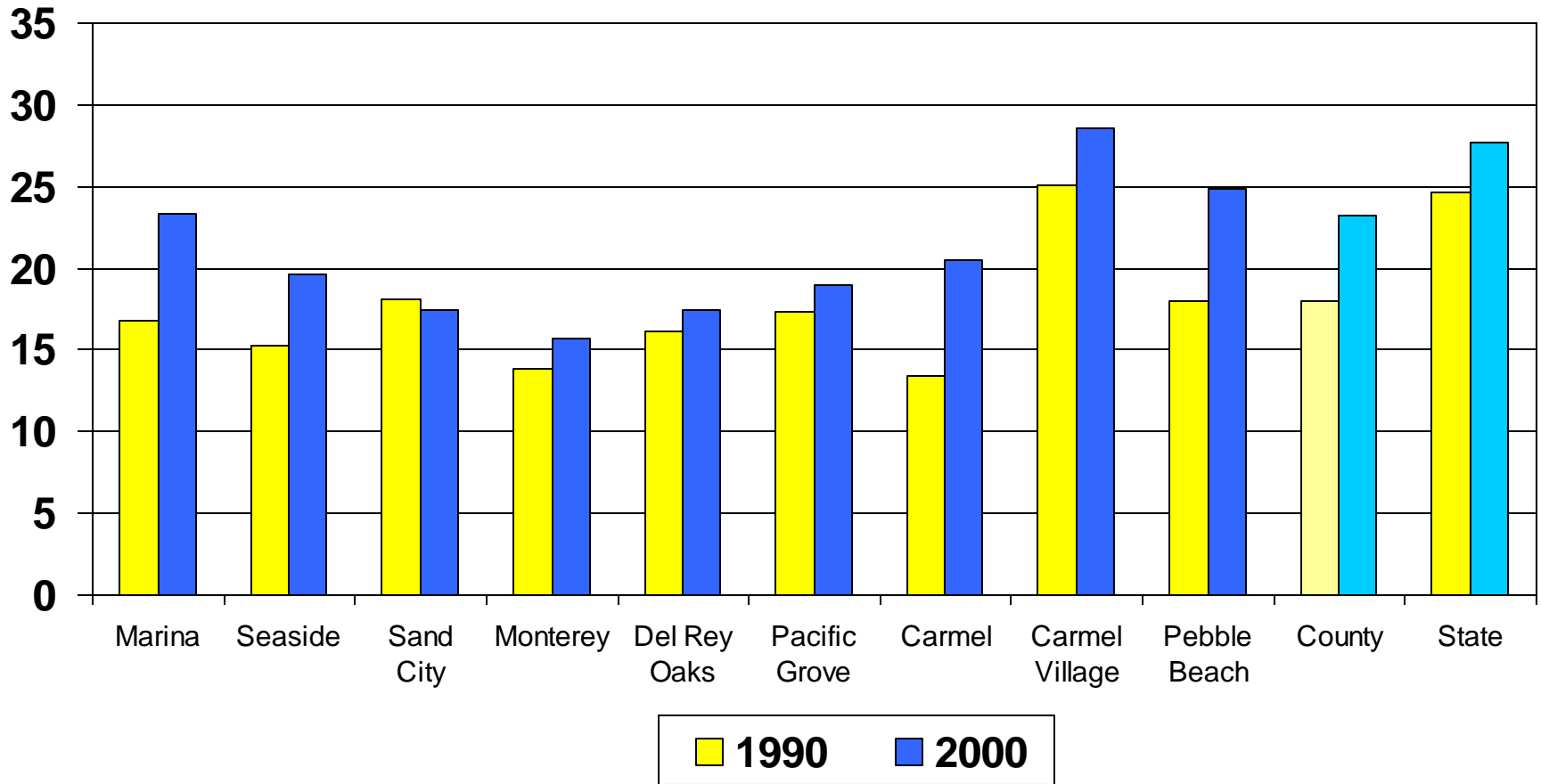
Employment Status – Community Armed Forces
