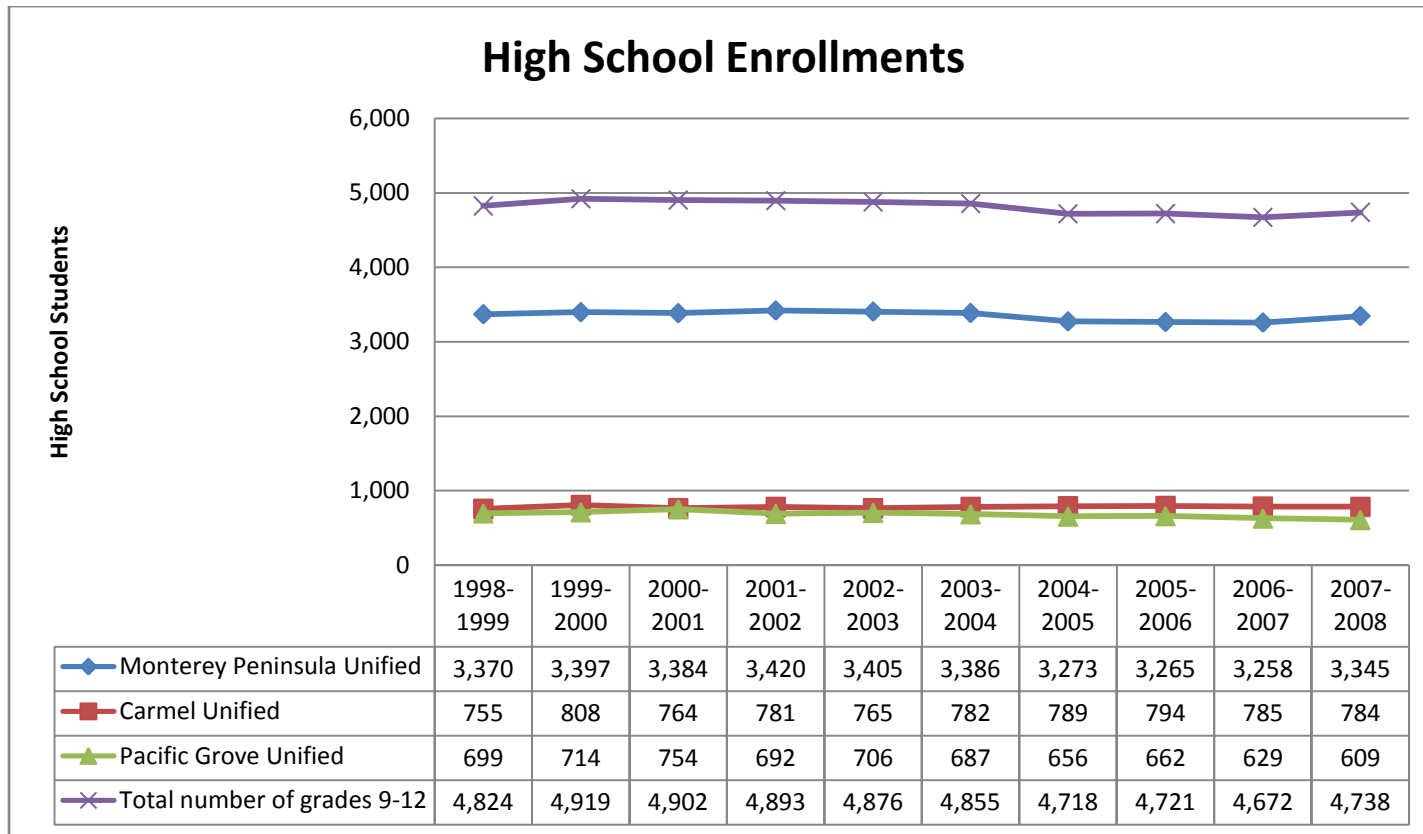

High School Enrollments

The graph below illustrates that public high school enrollments in MPC’s service area have remained flat over the last ten years; enrollments have averaged 4,910 students in grades 9-12 each year. Monterey Peninsula Unified School District (MPUSD) produces 5.5 times more students than Pacific Grove Unified & 4.3 times more than Carmel Unified.



High School Graduates

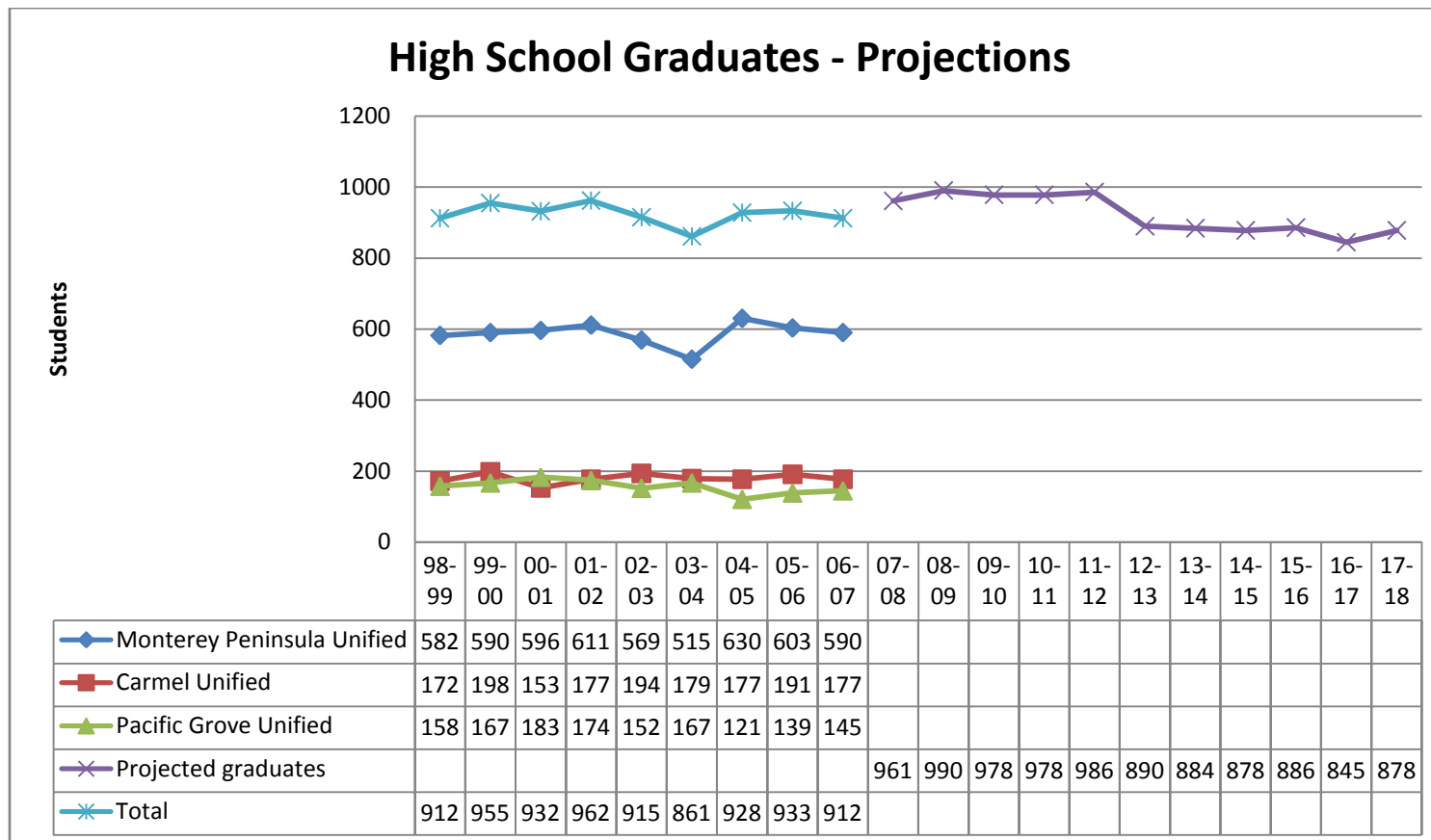
This table shows the number of graduates from public high schools in MPC's service area. Since 1998, the number of graduates has averaged 923 students per year.

High School Graduates - Projections

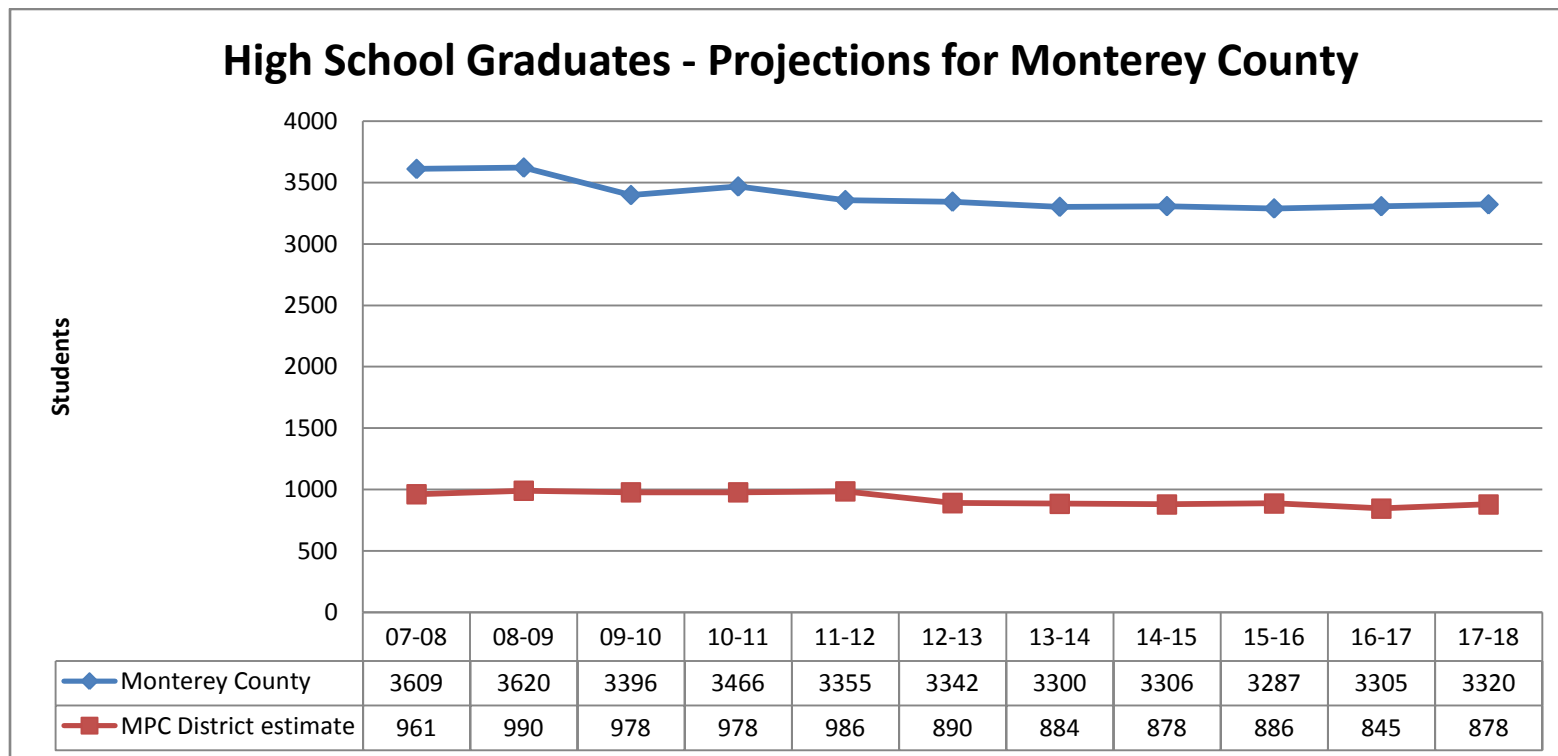

College-Going *Rates* to MPC

The table below shows the percentage of graduates from the four major local high schools that came to MPC the fall semester immediately after they graduated from high school. The 9 year average for Monterey High School was 41.6%; Pacific Grove High was 39.3%; Seaside High was 34.6%, and Carmel was 25.3%.

College Going Rates – All Segments

The combined college-going rate to UC, CSU, and CCC averaged 66.2% for the four K-12 districts in our service area. The college-going rate to MPC averaged 51.8% over 10 years.
