<p>Discussion Agenda</p>	<p>Change in Title 5 regarding Repetition and Withdrawal from Credit Courses - Michael Gilmartin</p> <p>Michael informed the committee of a change to Title 5 which will become effective October 12, 2011. The change requires credit courses be limited to being taken three (3) times in total. This total includes the combination of both completions and withdrawals for a course. The only exception will be for courses for which repeats are mandated by specific California codes, and for disabled students who can benefit from repeated instruction. The college will not be paid for the fourth or successive times a student takes a course. This requirement will be in place for colleges beginning the October 12, 2011; however, the Chancellor's office will not withhold FTES until Summer 2012. Depending on the number of students affected by this new requirement this new regulation may reduce FTES for the college.</p> <p>Michael suggests a blanket resolution to change repeat limits that are currently set to allow a course be taken four times. This will prevent the necessity to bring separate course revisions to CAC for each course requiring a change. Additionally, catalog and schedule description will need to be revised to reflect this change. He encourages CAC members to bring this information to their divisions for consideration of whether specific courses need to be restructured.</p> <p>Michael will review and draft revised Board Policy as necessary.</p>	<p>FYI</p>
