The committee felt that this program may need more focus and questioned the number of courses listed in this program. It was unclear what level of world language was being required or what was meant by ESL Credits accepted. <b>HOSP 68</b>	<p>HOSP 68 (<i>Introduction to Ecotourism</i>) is the first course developed for the new Ecotourism program. It will provide students the opportunity to learn the principles of responsible travel as well as the opportunity to utilize ecotourism for conservation and to improve local economies. The course catalog and schedule descriptions were discussed. Lynn will revise the wording accordingly.
