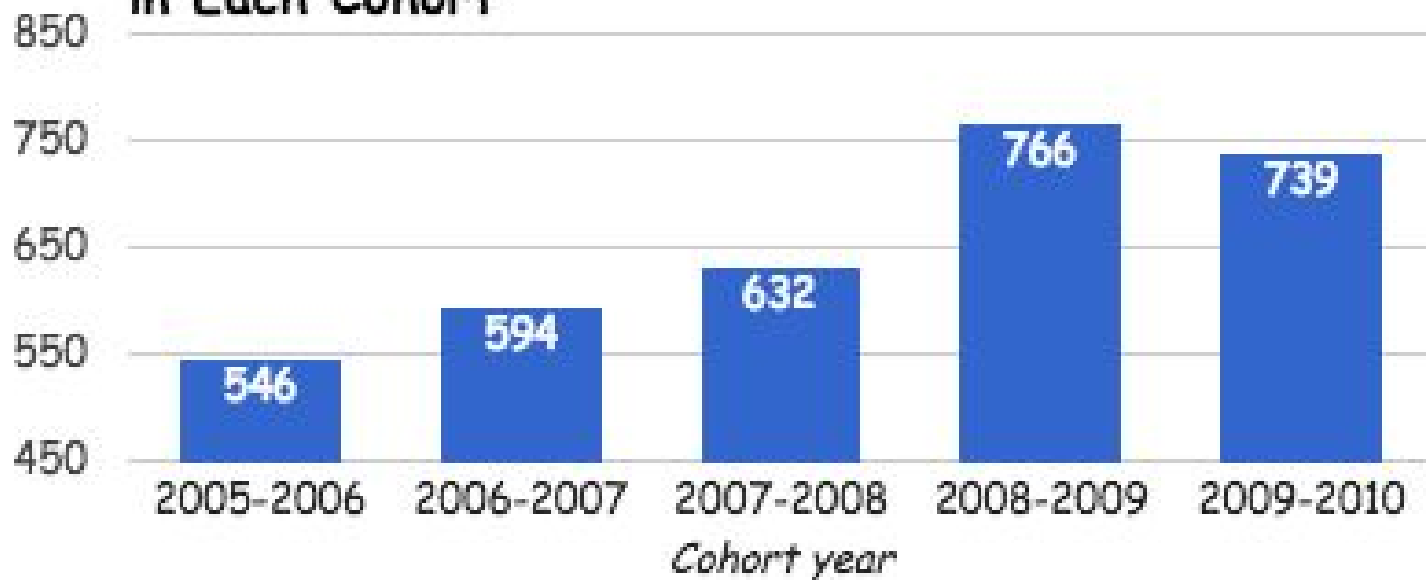

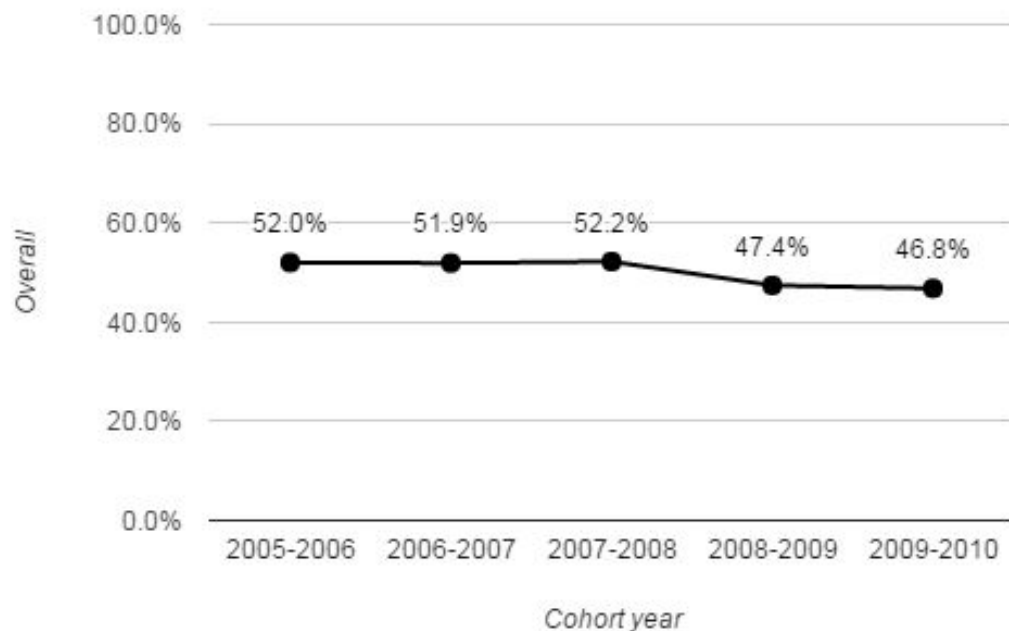
Scorecard Completion metric: Number of Students in Each Cohort

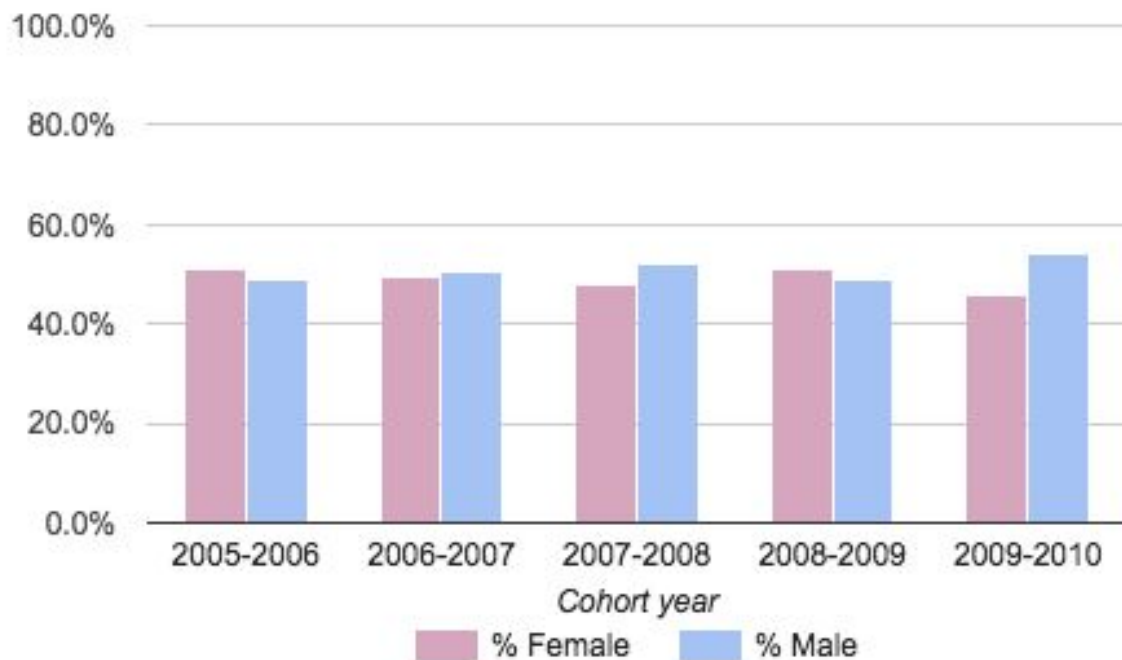
Scorecard Completion metric: Overall Completion Rate

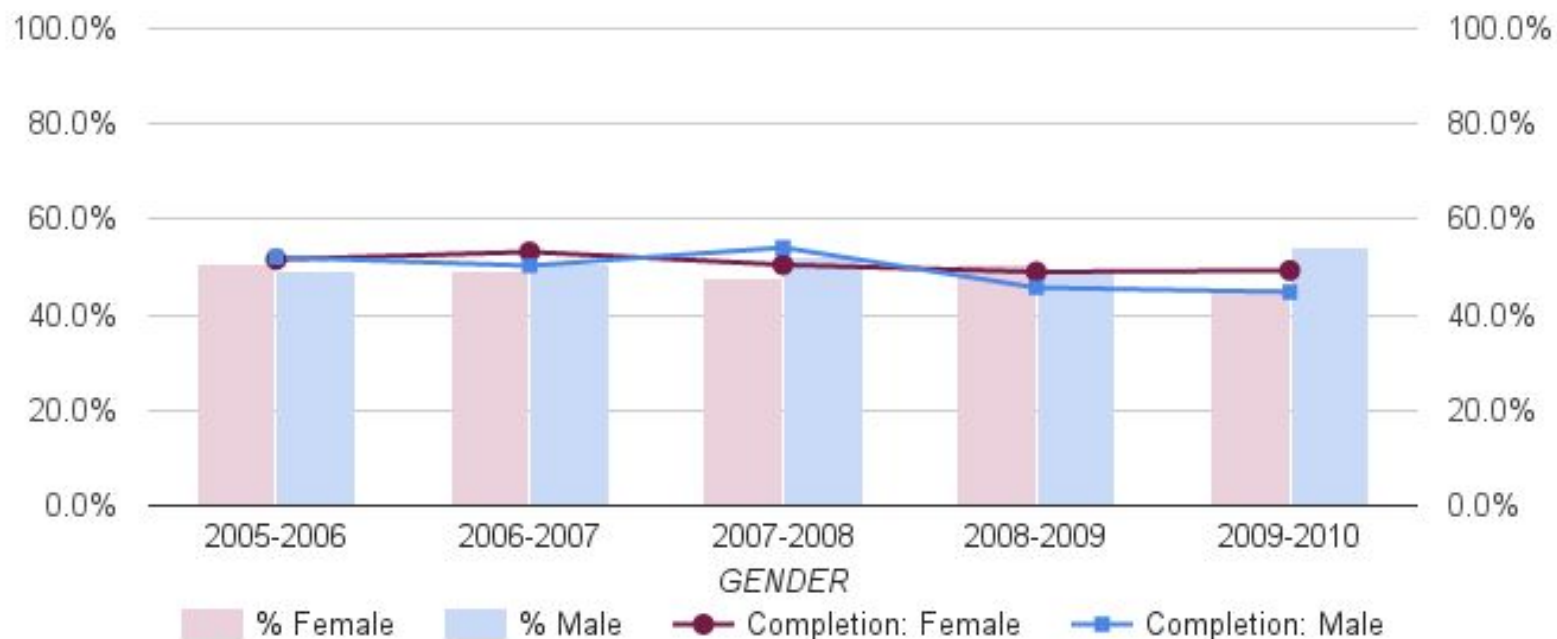
Scorecard Completion metric: Gender Profile

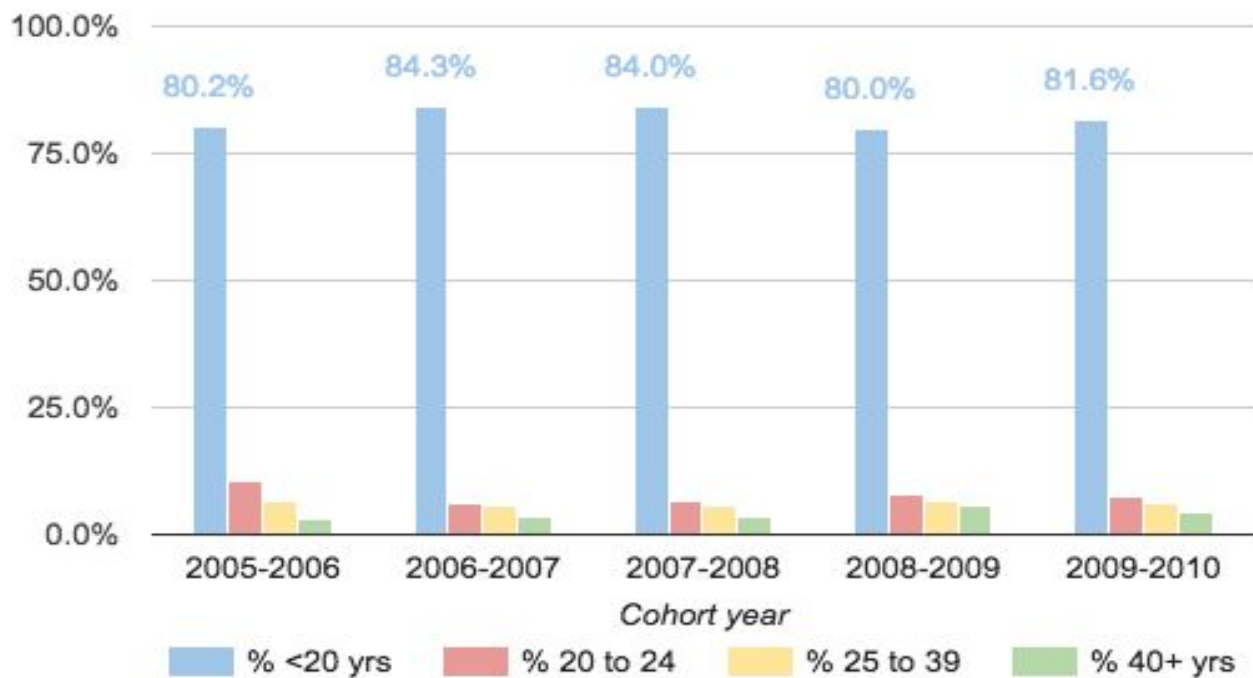
Scorecard Completion metric: Completion Rate for Females vs. Males

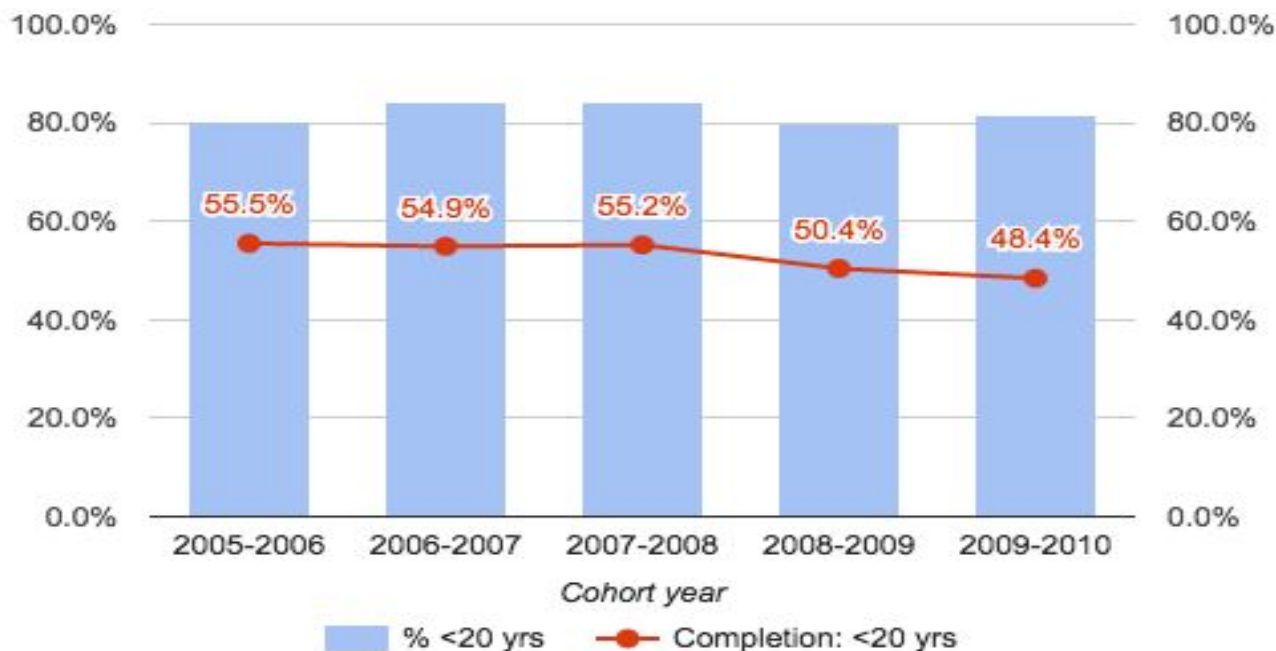
Scorecard Completion metric: Age Trends

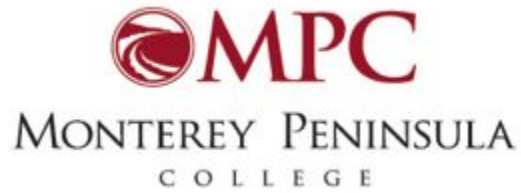

Ethnicity categories changed in 2009 -- No review of Ethnicity in today's presentation

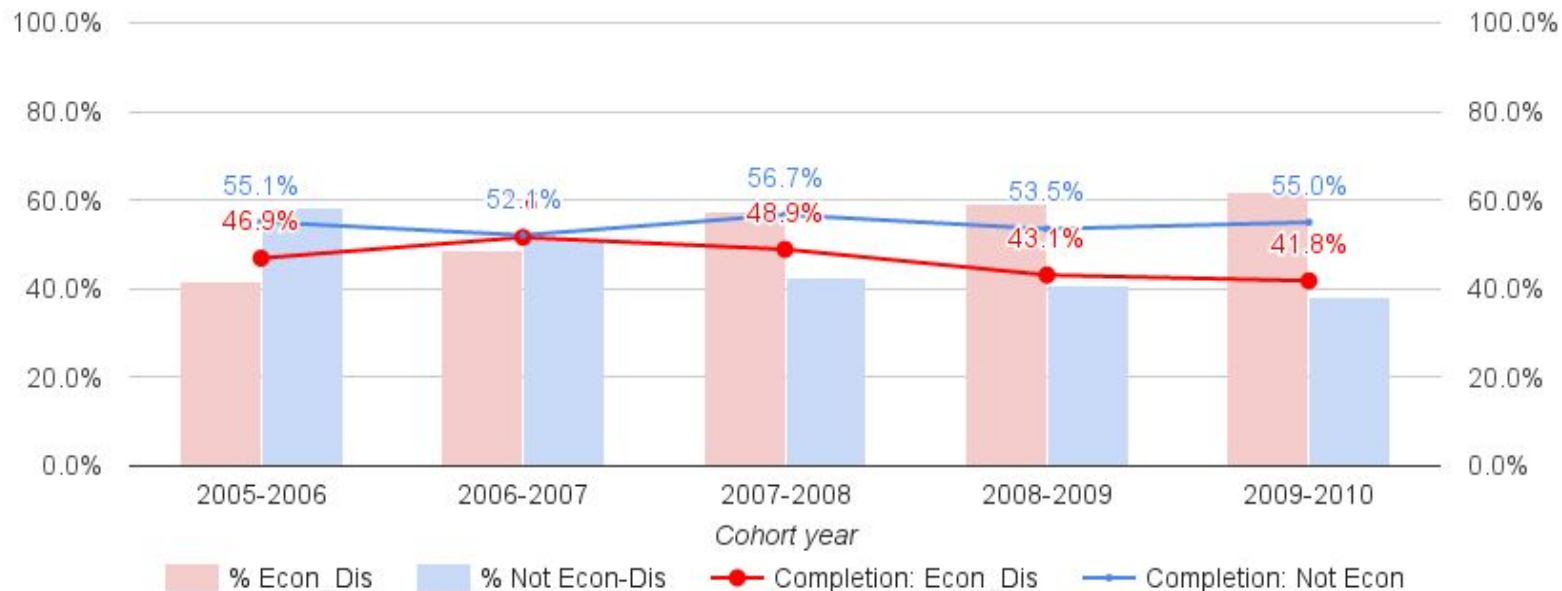

Scorecard Completion metric: Economically Disadvantaged Trends



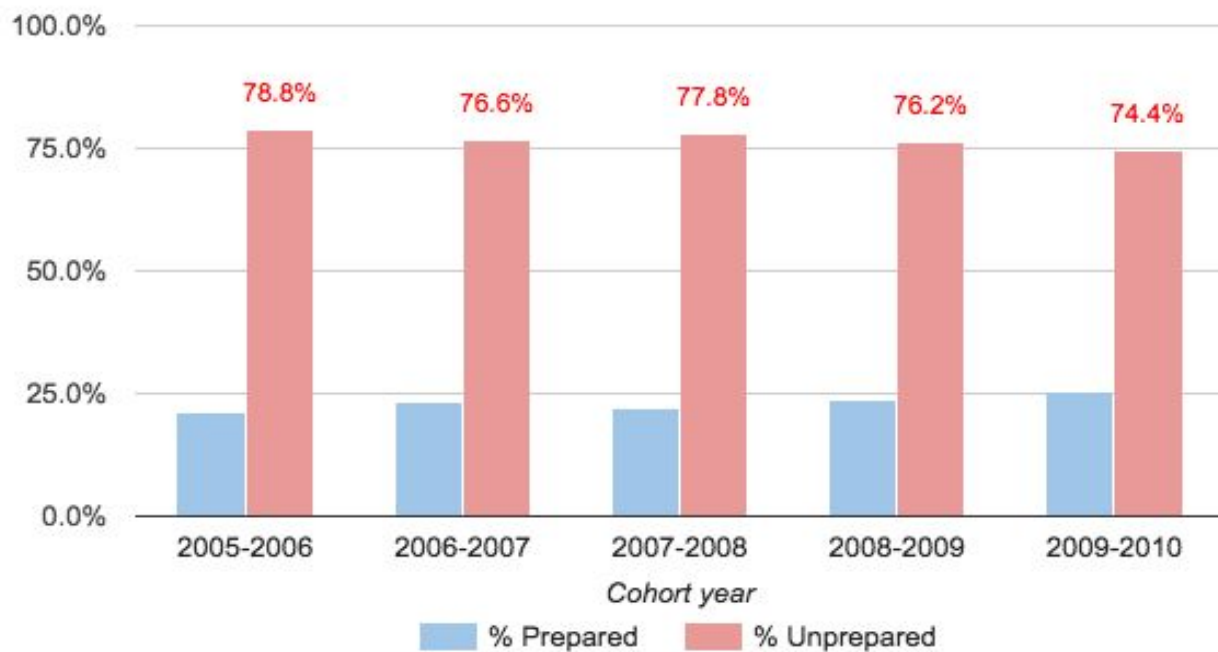
Scorecard Completion metric: Completion Rate for Economically Disadvantaged vs. Not Disadvantaged



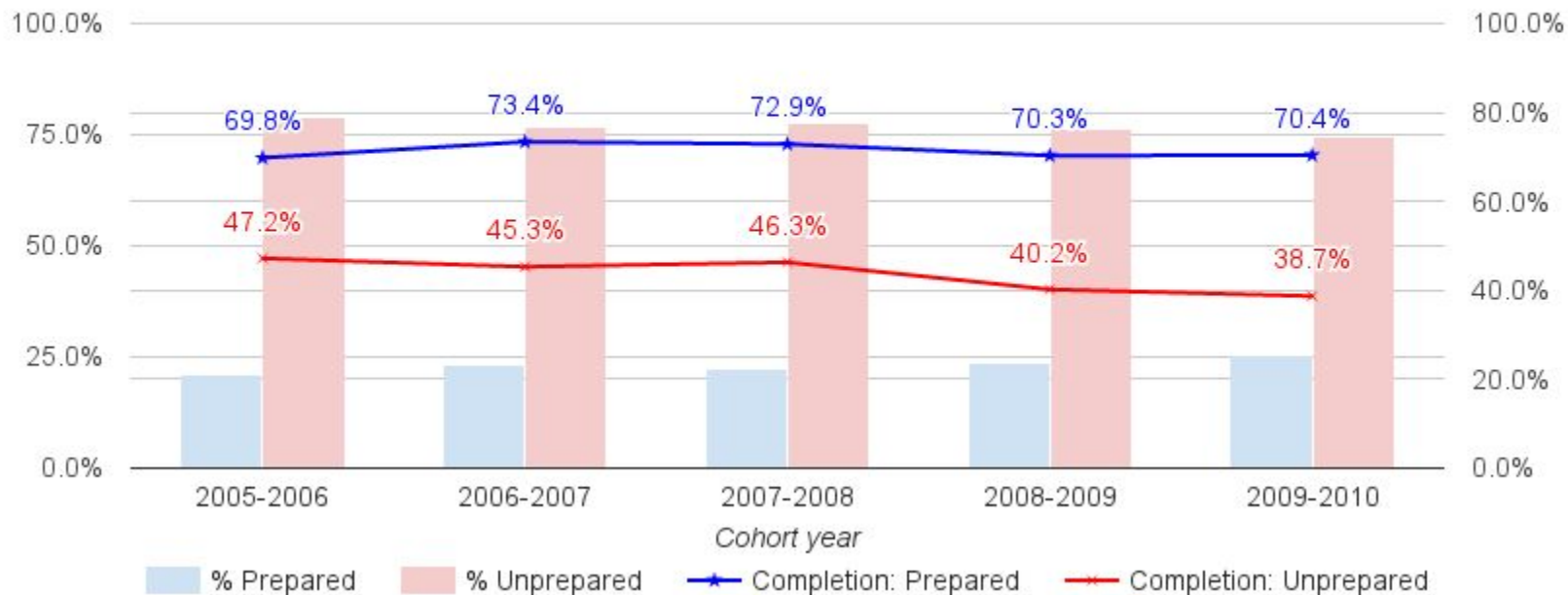

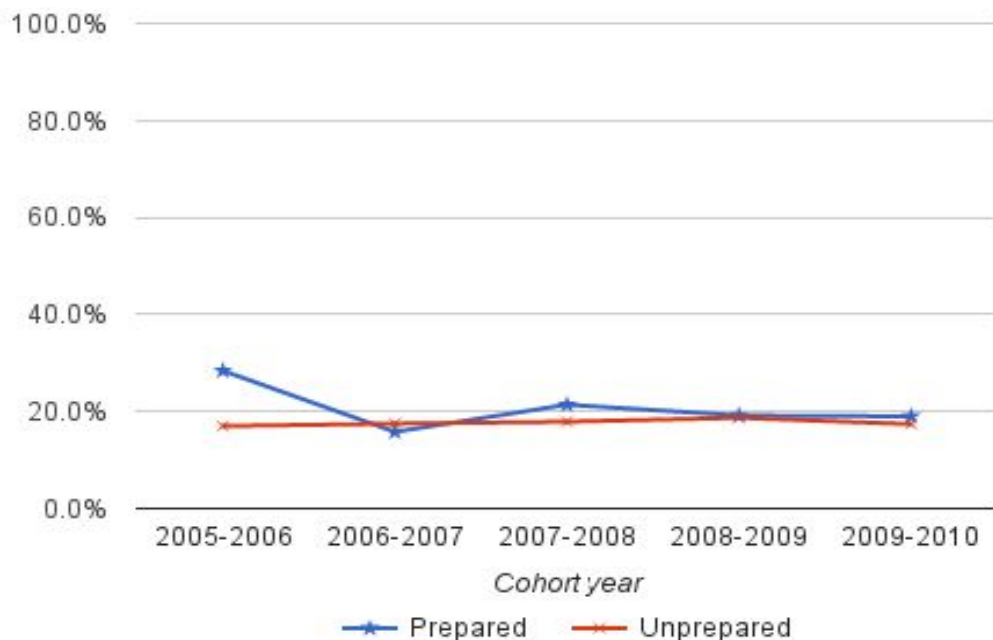
Students can achieve Completion by:

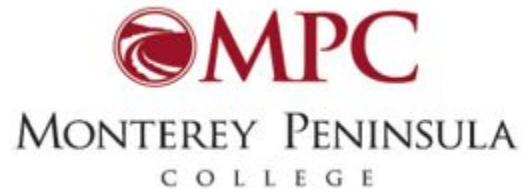
- ❖ Earning an AA/AS

Prepared vs. Unprepared**



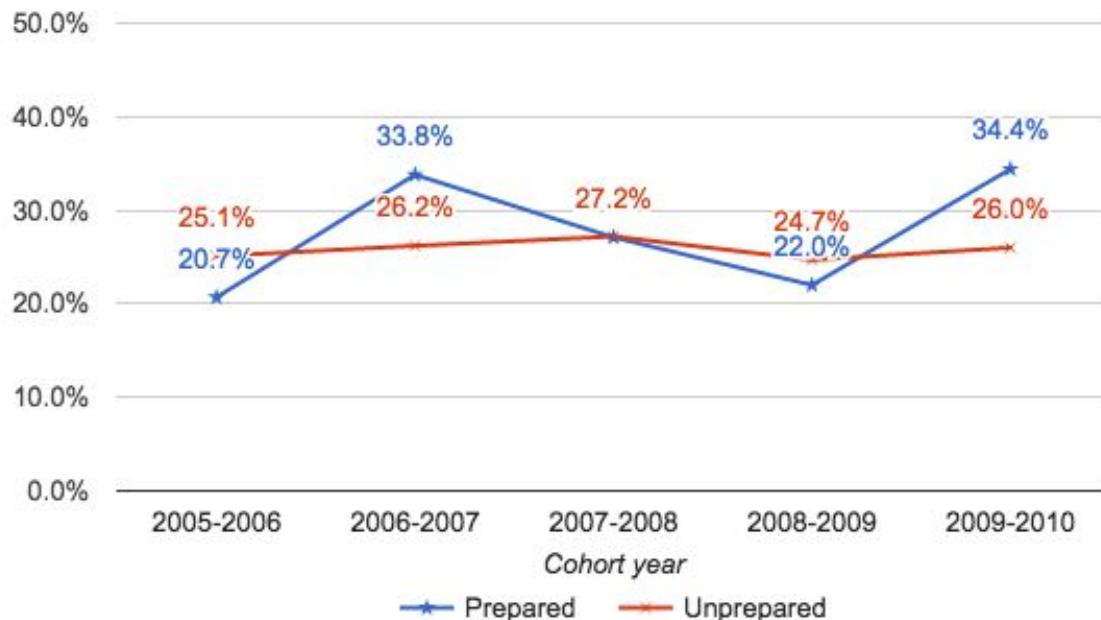


Scorecard Completion metric: Earned Certificate

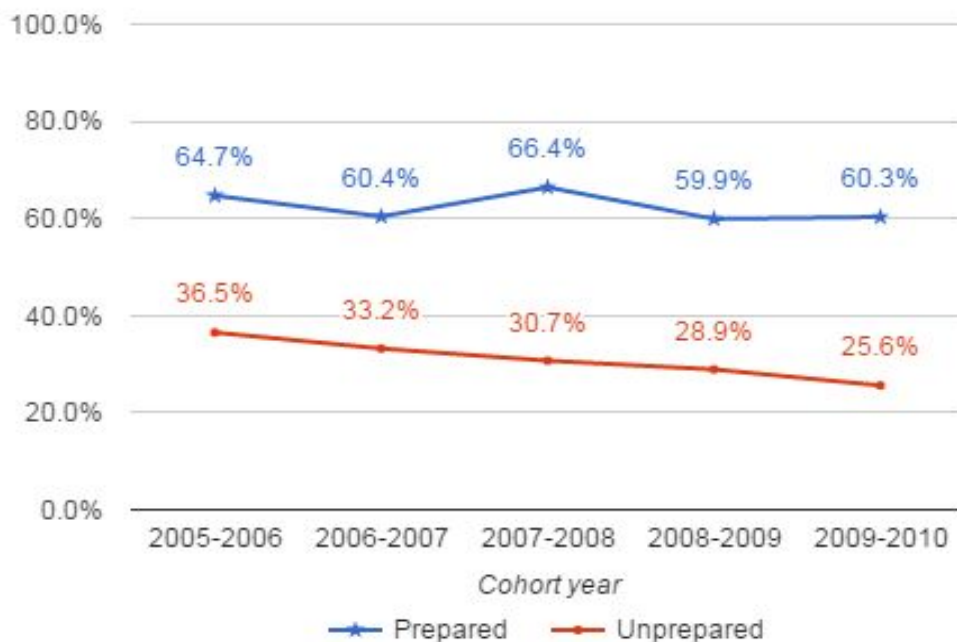
Scorecard Completion: Achieved Transfer Prepared Status, Prepared vs. Unprepared

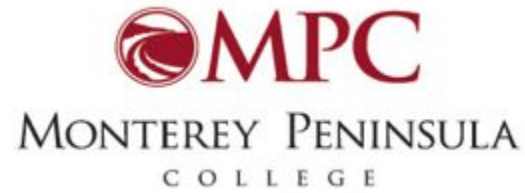

Transferred to 4-Year, Prepared vs. Unprepared



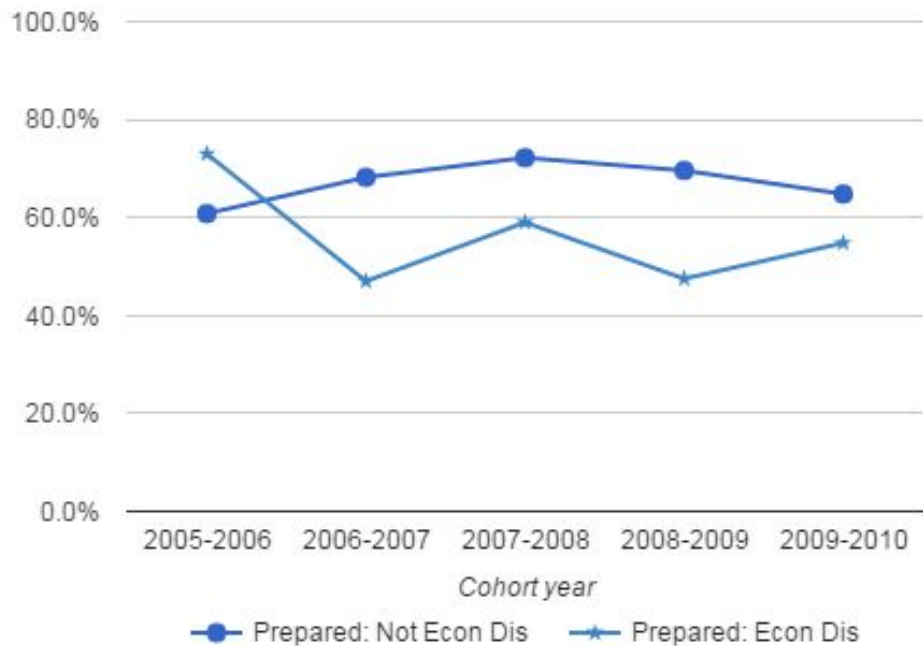


Transfer to a 4-Year: Does Economic Status matter?

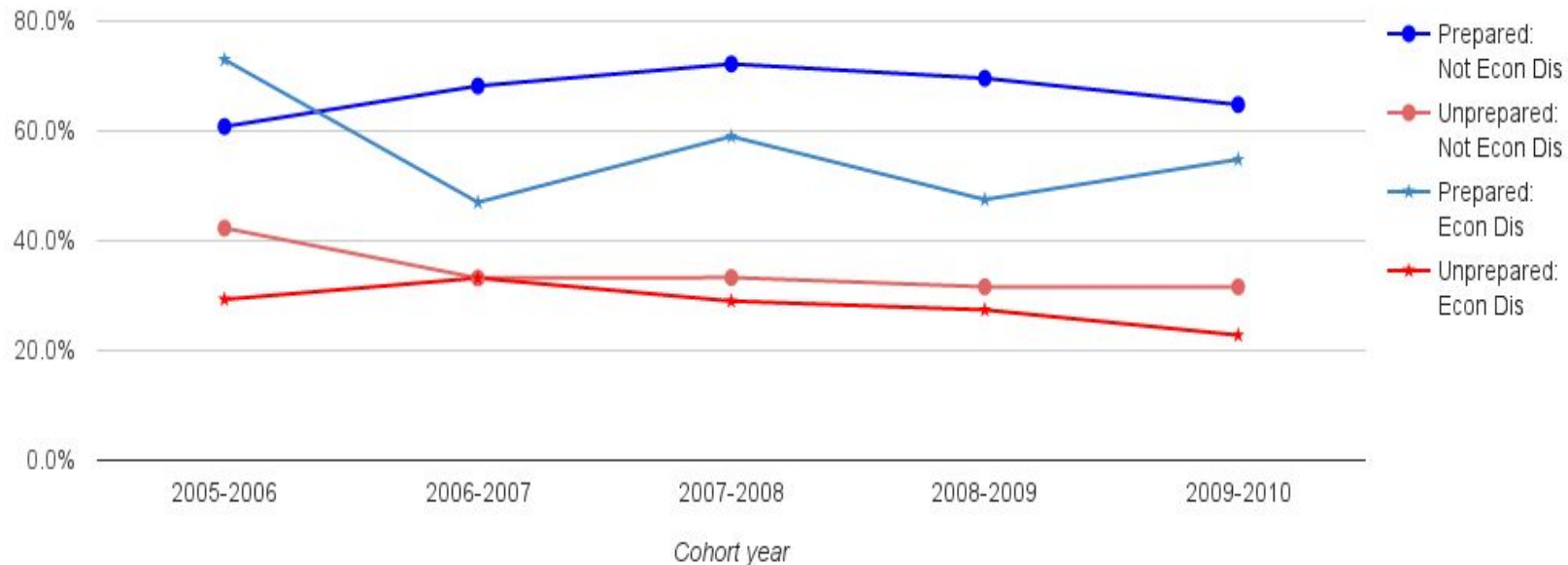
Transferred to 4-Year, Prepared Students by Economic Status
