## How to Cite Classroom Materials in MLA Style:

### Class Handout

**Description:**

Instructor's Last Name, First Name. "Title of Handout." Handout, Title of Course, Name of School, Date of Document (If no date listed, enter: n.d.).

\*Note: If any of the above information is not given, skip to the next available item.

**Example:**

Smith, Sarah. "Summary of the Four Idols." Handout, English 2: Argumentative Writing and Critical Thinking, Monterey Peninsula College, n.d.

### Class Handout Quoting another Source

**Description:**

Author of quoted source. "Title of work from a published collection (e.g., poem or article)." *Title of Publication (book or periodical)*, "Title of Handout," Handout, Title of course, Name of instructor, Name of school, Date of handout.

\*Note: If any of the above information is not given, skip to the next available item.

**Example:**

Whitman, Walt. "Song of Myself." *Leaves of Grass*, "Whitman Poems for Discussion," Handout, English 1B: Introduction to Literature, Professor Sarah Smith, Monterey Peninsula College, Feb. 2016.

### Class Lecture

**Description:**

Speaker. "Title" or description. Sponsoring event or course name, Location, Performance date, Type of performance (Address, Lecture, Keynote speech, Reading).

**Example:**

Smith, Sarah. "Walt Whitman." English 1B: Introduction to Literature, Monterey Peninsula College, 7 Mar. 2016, Lecture.
